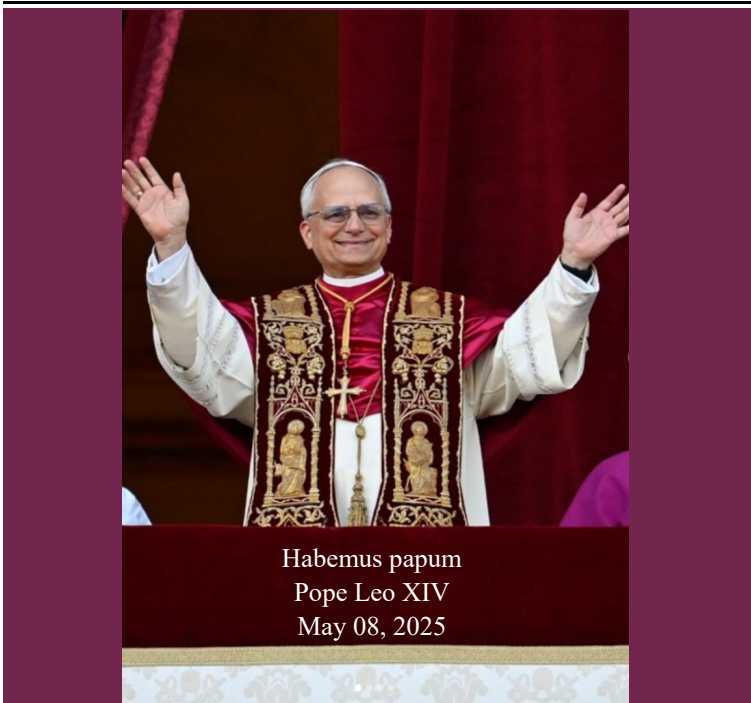

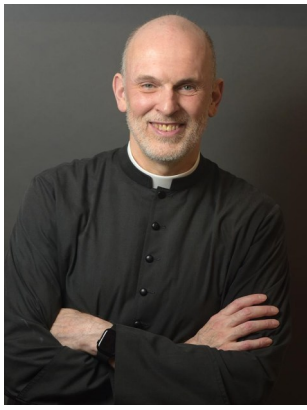

pastor's Corner

4th Sunday of Easter Good Shepherd Sunday Mother's Day & Vocations Sunday



This Sunday is traditionally known as *Good Shepherd Sunday*. It is also *Vocations Sunday*, and rightly so! The Good Shepherd calls each of us by name, but in a particular way, He calls some to assist Him in shepherding the flock - that is, the faithful of the Church. This day reminds us of the vital need to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Let me offer a few simple and practical helps:

- Teach your children to pray, and to pray *with you*.
 - Encourage them to read good and uplifting books.
 - Prioritize *real-life time* over screen time, except for school, or research.
- Bring them joyfully to Mass every Sunday, not begrudgingly.

These are simple yet powerful steps that open the heart to hearing the Lord's voice. So today and every day, let us pray for vocations.

May is traditionally dedicated to our Blessed

Mother. Mary is the *dawn who announces the Sun*, her Son, Jesus. Here are a few ways you can grow in love and devotion to her this month:

1. Pray the *Regina Caeli*, instead of the Angelus, at noon, or any time during the day.
2. Pray one

decade of the Rosary daily, or go for all five.

3. Attend Mass on Saturday mornings, especially on First Saturdays.

4. Pray three *Hail Mary's* before going to bed, asking for purity of heart.

Small habits like these can lead to great graces.

To all mothers: *thank you*. As I told the students of Notre Dame this week, God did not choose a human father, but He *did* choose a mother. We do not love our mothers because they are perfect, we love them because they are *our* mothers. A mother's love is more than biological, it is a sacred reflection of God's tenderness. Mothers are the heart of the family!

So don't just *say* "Happy Mother's Day", *live it*. Honor your mother every day, in word and action. Last Saturday, I had the great joy of baptizing the children of the adults who were received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. What a beautiful moment, 22 baptisms! We then enjoyed a wonderful luncheon, organized by Tina

本主日傳統上稱為**善牧主日**，同時也是**聖召主日**，這實在是再恰當不過的！善牧按名字召叫我們每一個人，祂也特別召叫一些人來協助祂牧養羊群——也就是教會內的信眾。這一天提醒我們，必須迫切地為司鐸聖召與度奉獻生活者的聖召祈禱。

容我提出幾個簡單而實際的建議：

- 教導你的孩子祈禱，並與他們一同祈

Good Shepherd Sunday
May 11, 2025

To the faithful of the Archdiocese of Vancouver,

We celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday as a day of gratitude to God for bringing forth shepherds from among his flock to serve the needs of the Church. As members of the body of Christ we have our own part to play in encouraging young men to discern a call to the priesthood. In a recent study, *78% new priests credit their pastors, and by extension, their home parishes, for supporting their vocations. Another 74% new priests say that their parents' encouragement was a key factor in discernment. Have you considered that a family member is called to the priesthood? Have you ever thought that a young man in the parish would make a good priest? Say something to him and assure him of your prayers. If you are a young man discerning God's will, visit our website vocationsvancouver.ca and take our Discernment Survey.

We have 21 seminarians who have the courage to step out in faith and discern a call to the diocesan priesthood. These young men are on a journey to understand God's will for them. It may be that during his time in seminary, a seminarian will recognize that he is being called to a different vocation. This is healthy, and we continue to thank these men for their willingness to follow Christ wherever He may lead.

There are more men entering the seminary for the Archdiocese of Vancouver this fall. Dozens more lay men are involved in the Discerner's Group and still more are in active discernment within their parish communities. With this second collection today, let us offer our prayers for young men to discern their call: as fathers of families, ordained Fathers within the Church, or consecrated Brothers and Fathers in religious life.
