Third Sunday of Lent

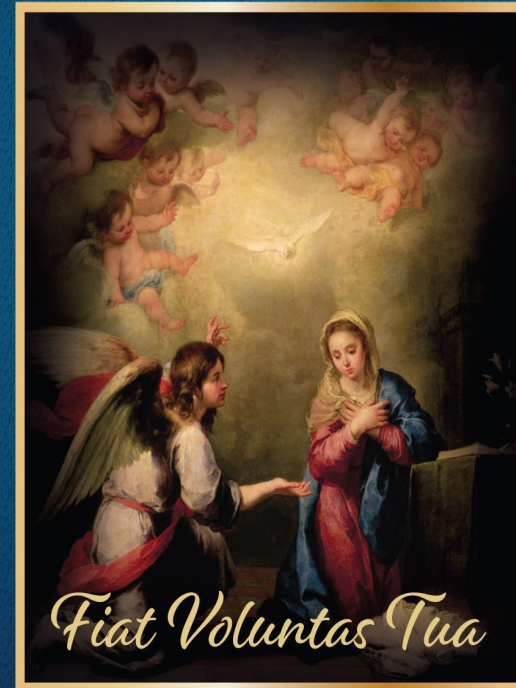
