#### 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### Corpus Christi Procession Photos

This coming Sunday, we will gather after the 11am Mass and give thanks to God for Fr. Salvino's priestly ministry here at Corpus Christi these past two years and to also wish him well in and pray for his new assignment at St. Joseph's Langley.

The month of July, in the Catholic devotional year, is devoted to the Precious Blood of Jesus.

- 1. **Biblical and Liturgical Foundation** The devotion to the Precious Blood flows from Scripture, where the blood of Christ is repeatedly emphasized as the means of our redemption (cf. *Hebrews 9:12, 1 Peter 1:18–19, Revelation 1:5*). The Church, especially on the feast of Corpus Christi and its extension, has long venerated the Blood of Christ as inseparable from the Eucharist.
- 2. **Historical Papal Endorsement** In 1849, Pope Pius IX instituted the Feast of the Precious Blood on July 1 after the political restoration of the Papal States. This was later elevated by Pope Pius X and included in the General Roman Calendar. Although the feast was removed from the universal calendar in 1969, the *Month of the Precious Blood* devotion continues as part of Catholic tradition.
- 3. **Theological Significance: Redemption and Covenant** The Precious Blood is the price of our salvation (cf. *Ephesians 1:7*) and the seal of the New and Eternal Covenant (cf. *Matthew 26:28*). It speaks of God's mercy, justice, and self-giving love.

By venerating the Blood of Christ, the Church calls the faithful to deeper gratitude for the mystery of the Passion and to join their sufferings to Christ's redeeming sacrifice.

#### 2 Ways Parishioners Can Live This Devotion in July

1. **Pray the Litany of the Precious Blood** Set aside time each day, or at least each Friday of July, to pray the **Litany of the Precious Blood**, approved by Pope John XXIII. It is a powerful meditation on Christ's sacrifice and a way to grow in devotion to His redemptive love.

#### The Litany of the Precious Blood

2. Offer Daily Sacrifices in Union with Christ's Blood I want to encourage parishioners to consciously offer their daily sufferings, inconveniences, or acts of charity, in union with the Precious Blood for the salvation of souls. This aligns with St. Paul's exhortation to "present your bodies as a living sacrifice" (*Romans 12:1*), thus sharing in Christ's redemptive mission.

## 常年期第十四主日 本堂神父的話

#### 聖體聖血節聖體遊行照片

本主日上午十一點彌撒後,我們將聚集一同感謝天主,感謝 Salvino 神父在聖體聖血堂過去兩年的司鐸服務,並為他即將前往蘭里聖若瑟堂的新牧職獻上祝福與祈禱。

在天主教信仰傳統中,七月是敬禮耶穌 寶血的月份。

#### 1. 聖經及禮儀基礎

對耶穌寶血的敬禮源自聖經,聖經中多次強調基督的寶血是我們得救贖的泉源(參閱:希伯來書9:12、伯多祿前書1:18-19、默示錄1:5)。教會特別在聖體聖血節及其延伸禮儀中,長久尊崇基督的寶血,視其與聖體不可分離。

#### 2. 歷史上的教宗支持

1849年,教宗庇護九世在教宗國度復辟後,訂立每年7月1日為「耶穌寶血慶日」。此後,教宗庇護十世將此節日提升至羅馬通用禮儀曆內。雖然該慶日在1969年後已從普世禮儀曆中移除,但「耶穌寶血之月」的敬禮仍持續存在於教會傳統中。

3. 神學意義:救贖與新約

耶穌寶血是我們得救的代價(參閱:厄弗所書 1:7),也是新而永久盟約的印證(參閱:瑪竇福音 26:28)。寶血彰顯天主的慈悲、公義和自我奉獻的愛。透過敬禮基督寶血,教會召喚信友對苦難奧跡懷有更深的感恩,並將自身的痛苦與基督的救贖犧牲結合。

#### 教友在七月實踐此敬禮的兩個方式

#### 1. 誦念耶穌寶血禱文連禱

鼓勵各位每天(或至少七月的每個星期五)撥出時間,誦念由教宗若望二十三世批准的《**耶穌寶血禱文連禱**》。此祈禱是對基督犧牲的深刻默想,也是增進對祂救贖之愛的敬禮方式。

#### 耶穌寶血禱文連禱

#### 2. 奉獻每日犧牲,與基督寶血結合

我鼓勵各位教友,有意識地將每天的痛苦、不便或愛德行動,與耶穌寶血結合,為眾靈的得救奉獻。這與聖保祿宗徒的勸勉一致:「獻上你們的身體當作生活的敬禮」(羅馬書 12:1),與基督的救贖使命合而為一。

## Mass and Donuts


Mix it up by going to a different Catholic Mass and splurge for donuts and coffee after!

This volunteer opportunity will count toward the school participation hours.


We have 3 schedules available:
