### 5th Sunday of Easter

Last week 68 students of our parish received the sacrament of Confirmation. This was such a blessing for me as the parish priest and I pray it will be a continued blessing for the families of those students who received the outpouring of the Holy Spirit through this powerful sacrament. The really challenging part will be to keep these Gr 7's connected to Jesus and his Church, connected to the sacraments, connected to Youth Ministry.



I reminded their parents and the students that they are not graduating from their faith, but launching into mission.

I encouraged the Gr 7's to a 3 step mission life-program!

Your 3-step mission:

- ✓ Show up at Mass – because Jesus is waiting.
- ✓ Plug into Youth Ministry – because you need your crew.

✓ Step up and shine – because the world needs your light.

I encouraged parents to recalibrate their priorities - i.e. to encourage their children to this 3step mission! It is very important that we pray for these students and their families. Our 10 Year Vision is working, but it needs everyone to respond to the Lord's calling.

This Friday evening, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, Archbishop Smith will be installed as our new Archbishop and Archbishop Miller will begin a new part of his life. He will be going to Texas to live with his religious community. If you desire to see the Installation it will be broadcast on the Cathedral YT and FB channel. The Mass begins at 7pm. Let us pray for Archbishop Smith as he begins his life as the Shepherd of our Archdiocese and at the same time keep Archbishop Miller in our prayers, giving thanks to God for the many years of faithful ministry in Vancouver.

This coming week I will on retreat at Westminster Abbey. The retreat begins Monday evening and goes through to Friday at 12pm. Pray for me and know that I will be praying for you.

Everyone will see our seminarian, Luis Esquivel. I know he will be made to feel welcomed here!

Let us continue to invoke our Blessed Mother during this month of May. May she lead us to be ever more united to the heart, mind and will of her Son, Jesus.
