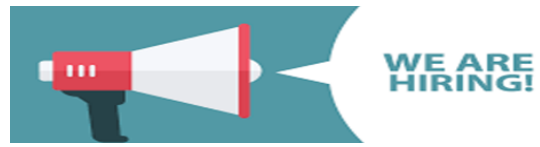

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time Engaged Disciples



Last Sunday I continued to reflect on the **Core Values of our 10-Year Vision** by looking at what it means to be **Engaged Disciples**.

Over these past few weeks we have seen wonderful examples of this at Corpus Christi: Vacation Bible School, our Altar Servers Camp, Youth Ministry Retreat, and the retreat of our Junior and Senior Youth Core Teams.

Why do we put so much prayer, time, energy, and resources into these things?

Simply put, we don't want children who attend programs, altar servers who serve Mass, or teenagers who go on retreats.

We want Engaged Disciples!

Young people, and adults, who **know Christ, love Christ, and serve Christ and others around them.**

In the first reading, God tells Ezekiel:

"Son of man, I have appointed you a watchman."

A watchman pays attention. He recognizes that other people have been entrusted to his care. He does not simply stand by. That gives us an important principle for discipleship:

The spiritual welfare of others is, in some measure, our responsibility.

Christianity is never simply **"Jesus and me."** Jesus places people in our lives whom we are called to love, encourage, accompany, invite, teach, pray for, and witness to.

This begins especially in our families. Parents have an irreplaceable responsibility to help their children **know Christ, love Christ, and serve Christ**. The parish is here to help, but it can never replace the family.

This week, ask yourself:

- **Who has Jesus entrusted to me?**
- **Who needs my prayer, encouragement, or invitation?**
- **Who could I invite to Mass, Alpha, Faith Studies, or another parish activity?**
- **Am I actively helping my children and family grow in faith?**
- **Am I simply attending church—or am I becoming an Engaged Disciple?**

Our Core Value says:

"Corpus Christi parishioners strive to be fully committed to holiness, mission, community, and service."

That is the kind of parish we are building together.

An Engaged Disciple doesn't simply ask, "How am I doing with Jesus?"

An Engaged Disciple also asks:

"Who has Jesus placed in my life that He wants me to help come to know Him?"

Let us keep each other in prayer!

This year, our goal is \$150,000 and if we reach our goal, more than \$84,000 will come back directly to Corpus Christi to support our parish needs and priorities.

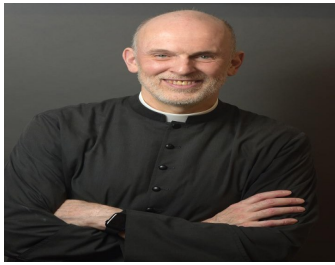

Pastor's Corner

常年期第二十四主日

本堂神父的話
投入的門徒



上主日，我繼續反思本堂十年願景的**核心價值**，特別是「投入的門徒」的真正意義。

在過去幾週，我們在本堂看見許多美好的例子：暑期聖經學校、輔祭營、青少年牧民退省，以及初高中核心團隊的退省。

為什麼我們願意在這些事工上投入大量祈禱、時間、精力與資源？

原因很簡單：我們不只是希望孩子來參加、輔祭在彌撒中服務、或青少年參加退省。

我們希望他們成為 投入的門徒！

成為真正 **認識基督、愛慕基督、並服務基督**及身邊弟兄姊妹的青年與成人。

在第一篇讀經中，天主對厄則克耳說：

「人子啊，我立你作守望者。」

守望者會留心觀察，他知道有人被託付在他的照顧之下，他不會袖手旁觀。

這為門徒生活指出一項重要原則：

他人的靈性福祉，在某種程度上，是我們的責任。

基督信仰從來不是「只有耶穌和我」。耶穌把一些人放在我們生命中，邀請我們去愛他們、鼓勵他們、陪伴他們、邀請他們、教導他們、為他們祈禱，並向他們作見證。

這尤其從家庭開始。父母對孩子有不可替代的責任：幫助他們**認識基督、愛慕基督、並服務基督**。堂區可以協助，但永遠不能取代家庭。

本週，請你自問：

- 耶穌把誰託付給我？
- 誰需要我的祈禱、鼓勵或邀請？
- 我可以邀請誰來參加彌撒、Alpha、信仰培育或其他堂區活動？
- 我是否積極幫助我的孩子與家人增進信仰？

我只是「來上教堂」——還是正在成為一位投入的門徒？

我們的核心價值寫道：

「Corpus Christi 的教友努力在聖德、使命、團體與服務上全心投入。」

這正是我們一起建立的堂區。

投入的門徒不只問：「我和耶穌的關係如何？」

投入的門徒也會問：

「耶穌在我生命中放了哪些人，是祂希望我幫助他們更認識祂？」

讓我們彼此代禱！
