

# 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time Part 1



# Transformed to Lead: Lessons from the Acts XXIX Immersive

This past week, Fr. Patrick, a small team from Corpus Christi and I, joined 2 other parish teams from our Archdiocese, in **Detroit** for an *Immersive* with **Fr. John Riccardo** and the **Acts XXIX Team**. What we experienced there was nothing short of a spiritual renewal, a time of *clarity, conviction, and communion* that is reshaping how we understand leadership and mission here at Corpus Christi.

#### 1. Outcomes of the Immersive

We came away with three clear graces, three outcomes that the Acts XXIX team led us to pray for all week:

- Be renewed in our relationship with Jesus Christ! Everything begins with personal amazement at who Jesus is and what He has done. Fr. Riccardo reminded us, "You can't preach morality until people are overwhelmed by the love of God." We were called to re-center our lives and ministries on this daily amazement.
- Be fired up for the mission we were born for! We are not in an age of comfort, but in a moment of *apostolic mission*. We are being sent "behind enemy lines" to rescue our brothers and sisters who are held captive by fear, confusion, and unbelief and not as warriors of anger, but as witnesses of hope.
- Forever change the way we make decisions!

  Decisions in the Church must flow from *prayer*, *unity*, *and mission*, not preference, politics, or pressure. We

  practiced a new way of discerning God's will together,

  one that is docile to the Holy Spirit and deeply relational.

## 2. Impediments We Must Address

Throughout the week, the team named and prayed through specific **impediments** — obstacles that keep parish leadership from being truly apostolic:


- 1. Failing to recognize what's most important right now. Like Martha, we can become busy with much serving, yet miss the "one thing necessary." The urgent often crowds out the important and that important thing is always our encounter with Jesus.
- 2. **Distorted image of God the Father.** Many struggle to believe that God is truly good, trustworthy, and close. The enemy's ancient lie still whispers, "You can be happier without Him." We must keep proclaiming that God's love is *unconditional and pursuing*, like the Father who ran to embrace the prodigal son.Him."
- **3. Misunderstanding of leadership.** Leadership in the Church is not about control, or function, but relationship and service. True authority is given to make others flourish, to *augment* life, not manage it.
- **4. Lack of authentic discernment.** Too often our meetings are "horizontal," more strategic than spiritual. We learned to begin *in prayer, not with prayers*, listen, not just plan.
- **5. Confusion and distraction.** The enemy's tactics are consistent: isolate, discourage, and confuse. We must protect unity, as St. Paul urges, "Be over-zealous to preserve the bond of peace" (Eph 4:3).

3 常年期第二十九主日本堂神父的話(一)



轉化以領導:來自Acts XXIX沉浸式體驗的啟示

上週,我與Corpus Christi的Patrick神父及一小組成員,連同本總教區的另外兩個堂區團隊,一同前往底特律,參加由JohnRiccardo神父和ActsXXIX團隊主持的沉浸式靈修。我們在那裡經歷了一場靈性更新,一段清晰、堅定與共融的時光,正在重塑我們對領導與使命的理解

- 。一、沉浸式體驗的成果我們帶回了三項明確的 恩典,也是Acts XXIX團隊整週引導我們祈禱的三 個果實:
- 更新我們與耶穌基督的關係!
- 一切始於對耶穌是誰、祂所成就的個人驚嘆。 Riccardo神父提醒我們:「在人們被天主的愛深深 震撼之前,你無法宣講道德。」我們被召喚將生 活與事工重新聚焦於這份每日的驚嘆。
- 為我們天生的使命燃起熱火!

我們所處的不是安逸的時代,而是使徒使命的時刻。我們被派遣至「敵陣後方」,去拯救那些被恐懼、混亂與不信所囚禁的弟兄姊妹,不是以憤怒的戰士身份,而是希望的見證人。 · 徹底改變我們的決策方式! 教會中的決策應源自祈禱、合一與使命,而非偏好、政治或壓力。我們

- 一起學習了一種新的辨識天主旨意的方式,順服 聖神、並深具關係性的方式。
- 二、我們必須面對的阻礙整週期間,

團隊點出並祈禱處理了幾項具體的阻礙——那些使堂區領導無法真正成為使徒性團體的障礙:

1.未能辨識當下最重要的事。如同瑪爾大,我們可能忙於服事,卻錯過了「唯一需要的事」。緊急的事常常排擠了重要的事,而那重要的事,永遠是我們與耶穌的相遇。

2.對天主聖父的形象扭曲。許多人難以相信天主 真的是良善、可信且親近的。魔鬼古老的謊言仍 在低語:「沒有祂,你會更快樂。」我們必須不 斷宣講:天主的愛是無條件的、是追尋的,一如 同那位奔向浪子擁抱的父親。

3.對領導的誤解。教會中的領導不是控制或職 能,而是關係與服務。真正的權柄是為了使他人 茁壯、促進生命,而非管理生命。

4.缺乏真正的辨識。我們的會議常常是「水平的」,更偏向策略而非靈修。我們學習從祈禱開始,而非只是祈禱詞;學習傾聽,而非僅僅計畫。

5.混亂與分心。魔鬼的策略始終如一:孤立、沮喪與混亂。我們必須守護合一,正如聖保祿所勉勵:「要竭力保存和平的聯繫」(厄4:3)




