During the month of November, it is important to pray for the souls in purgatory.

“It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from their sins.”

- 2 Maccabees 12:46

Why Our Prayers Matter

1. Act of Charity and Communion

When we pray for the Holy Souls, we live the *Communion of Saints*, the unbroken bond between the Church on earth, in purgatory, and in heaven.

2. Mercy for Those Being Purified

Purgatory is the merciful fire of God’s love preparing souls for heaven. Our prayers help them on this journey.

3. Remembering the Forgotten

Many souls have no one to pray for them. Offering prayers for *the most forgotten souls* is a beautiful act of compassion.

4. Hope in the Resurrection Each prayer reminds us of our eternal destiny and deepens our trust in the promise of new life in Christ.

5. Grace Flows Both Ways

As we intercede for the departed, they, in turn, intercede for us before God, a sacred exchange of love and grace.

Three Ways to Help the Holy Souls This November

Have Mass Offered

Request a Mass for deceased loved ones or for *the most forgotten souls in purgatory*.

Pray Daily for Them

Add the *Eternal Rest Prayer* to your day:
Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

Offer the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet

Unite your prayers to the mercy of Christ for all who long to see His face.

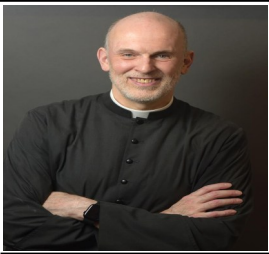

在十一月裡，為煉靈祈禱是非常重要的。

「為亡者祈禱，使他們脫離罪惡，確是一件聖善的思想。」——《瑪加伯下》12:46

為何我們的祈禱如此重要

一、愛德與共融的行動

當我們為煉靈祈禱時，我們正活出「諸聖相通」的奧跡——地上的教會、煉獄中的教會、以及天上的教會之間不斷的連結。

二、為受潔淨者施予仁慈

煉獄是天主慈愛之火，使靈魂為進入天堂作準備。我們的祈禱能助他們在這條潔淨之路上前行。

三、記念被遺忘的靈魂

許多靈魂無人為他們祈禱。為最被遺忘的煉靈祈禱，是一項充滿憐憫的美善行為。

四、在復活中懷抱希望

每一次祈禱，都提醒我們自身永恆的命運，並加深我們對基督新生命許諾的信賴。

五、恩寵的雙向流動

當我們為亡者代禱時，他們也會在天主面前為我們轉禱，這是一份神聖的愛與恩寵的交流。

今年十一月幫助煉靈的方式

一、奉獻彌撒

為已亡的親友或最被遺忘的煉靈請求舉行一台彌撒聖祭。

二、每日為他們祈禱

每天誦念「永恆安息經」：

主啊，求祢賜給他們永恆的安息，並以祢的光明照耀他們。願他們安息於平安中。亞孟。

三、誦念玫瑰經或慈悲串經

將你的祈禱與基督的仁慈結合，為所有渴望見到祂聖容的靈魂祈禱。
