Clam Chowder OR Vegetable Soup and a bun will be served . Coffee & Tea provided

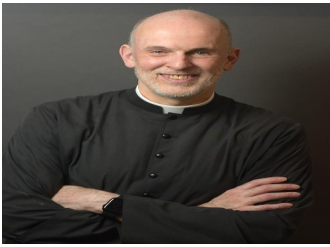
Tickets will be available after all masses on 28 / 29 and at the parish office.

Palm Sunday



Holy Week is upon us. It begins this Sunday with Palm Sunday and leads us into the most sacred days of the entire year.

This is not an ordinary week.

This is **the week that changed everything**.

So, as disciples of Jesus, we must be intentional. We need to **make time, invest time, and choose to walk with Him** through these holy days.

1. Be With Jesus – Intentionally

The first and most important way we accompany Jesus is through the **Holy Sacrifice of the Mass**.

You are already here, that matters, but if you are able, I encourage you to go further:

- Attend an extra Mass during Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday
- Spend time daily with **Sacred Scripture**, especially the Gospels
- Read also the First Readings, many from Isaiah, which prophetically reveal Christ

If you cannot attend daily Mass, then **create space at home**:

- Turn off the television
- Reduce screen time
- Open the Scriptures

Everyone can do this!

2. Finish Lent Well

Even if Lent has not gone as you hoped—**do not give up**.

Do not let discouragement become an excuse.

Instead:

- **Renew your resolve**
- **Recommit to your penances**
- **Finish strong**

It is not about how you started.

It is about how you finish.

Ask Jesus for the grace. He will help you.

3. Enter the Sacred Triduum

The heart of Holy Week is the **Triduum**—Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

Holy Thursday (7:00 PM)

We celebrate the **Mass of the Lord's Supper**:

- The institution of the Eucharist
- The institution of the priesthood

We are reminded: **we need the priest**. Through the priest, Christ gives us the sacraments: Baptism, the Eucharist, Confession, and Anointing.

After Mass, we will have **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Confessions**.

Stay. Watch. Pray.

Good Friday

- **11:00 AM – Stations of the Cross**
- **3:00 PM – Celebration of the Lord's Passion**

This is the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated.

Yet, this is **the day of victory!**

Not Easter Sunday.

Good Friday.

This is the day Christ conquered sin and death.

Also remember:

☒ It is a day of fasting and abstinence.

Write it down. Put it on your fridge. Help yourself to not forget!

Holy Saturday & Easter Vigil (9:00 PM)

On Holy Saturday, we wait in silence.

Christ descends to the dead, freeing the righteous and opening the gates of heaven.

Then comes the **Easter Vigil**, the most beautiful liturgy of the entire year.

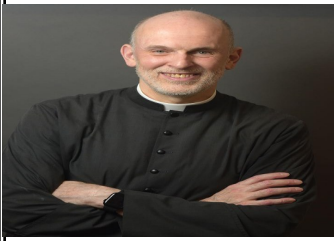
This year:

- **22 adults will be baptized**
- **2 will be received into full communion**

This is the **announcement of the victory of Jesus Christ and the fruits of our 10 Year Vision!**

May God bless you as you enter deeply into these sacred days.

聖枝主日 本堂神父的話



聖週已臨到我們眼前。本主日以聖枝主日揭開序幕，引領我們進入全年最神聖的日子。

這不是一個普通的星期。

這是一個**改變一切**的星期。

因此，作為耶穌的門徒，我們必須有意識地準備。我們需要**抽出時間、投放時間**，並選擇在這些神聖的日子裡**與祂同行**。

一、刻意地與耶穌同在

我們陪伴耶穌的第一個、也是最重要的方式，就是參與**彌撒聖祭的奉獻**。

你今天已經來到這裡——這非常重要。但如果你能做到，我鼓勵你更進一步：

- 在星期一、星期二或星期三多參與一次平日彌撒
- 每天花時間閱讀**聖經**，特別是福音
- 也閱讀第一篇讀經，其中許多選自依撒意亞先知書，先知性地揭示基督

若你無法參與平日彌撒，那麼請在家中創造一個**神聖的空間**：

- 關掉電視
- 減少螢幕時間
- 打開聖經

每個人都能做到！

二、好好完成四旬期

即使你的四旬期並未如你所願——**也不要放棄**。

不要讓氣餒成為藉口。

相反地：

- **更新你的決心**
- **重新投入你的補贖**
- **堅強地走完最後一段路**

重點不在於你如何開始。

而在於你如何結束。

向耶穌祈求恩寵——祂一定會幫助你。

三、進入逾越聖三日

聖週的核心是**逾越聖三日**——聖週四、聖週五與聖週六。

聖週四（晚上 7:00）

我們慶祝主的**晚餐彌撒**：

- 聖體聖事的建立
- 司鐸職務的建立

我們被提醒：**我們需要司鐸**。藉著司鐸，基督把聖事賜給我們：聖洗、聖體、告解與傅油。

彌撒後，我們將舉行**明供聖體與修和聖事**。

留下來。守候。祈禱。

聖週五

- **上午 11:00 —— 十四處苦路**
下午 3:00 —— 主受難禮儀

這是一年當中唯一沒有舉行彌撒的日子。

然而，這卻是**勝利的一天**！

不是復活主日。

而是**聖週五**。

這是基督戰勝罪惡與死亡的日子。

也請記得：

☞ 這是一個守大齋和小齋的日子。

把它寫下來，貼在冰箱上，提醒自己不要忘記！

聖週六與復活前夕守夜禮（晚上 9:00）

聖週六，我們在沉默中守候。

基督下降陰府，釋放義人，並為他們開啟天國之門。

接著便是**復活前夕守夜禮**——全年最美麗的禮儀。

今年：

- **22 位成人將領受洗禮**
- **2 位將加入完全共融**

這是**耶穌基督勝利的宣告**，也是我們「十年願景」的成果！

願天主在你深入進入這些神聖日子時，降福你。
