



pastor's Corner

3rd Sunday of Easter



"I put before you the one great thing to love on earth: the Blessed Sacrament." J.R.R. Tolkien. Tolkien was not only one of the great story writers of all time he was also a devout Catholic who had a strong, deep and personal faith in the Read Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

For this month of April devoted to the Blessed Sacrament, in our Catholic Calendar Year, you probably expected a quote from a saint, or Catechism reference, but this famous author of the Lord of the Rings and Hobbit says something the saints would all agree with.

Instead of loving idols, let's worship and adore Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. During this month we have also celebrated Divine Mercy Sunday and we continue to pass through the Easter season leading up to the Ascension of Jesus into heaven, which is in May. He is truly present in the Eucharist, and we are surrounded by the Holy Spirit.

If you don't fully embrace the Eucharist as the True Presence of Jesus Christ, His Body, and Blood, perhaps read up on it and pray for God's guidance to help any unbelief you may have about it.

In this month of April I ask all of you to pray for the Grade 2 students of our parish who will be receiving their First Holy Communion on Saturday, April 27th at 9:00am. On that day there will be NO 8:00am Mass. I will repeat this message again. The Church will be full that morning as we have around 75 Grade 2 students from our School and PREP.

It is so important that we pray for the parents of these children! That they follow through on the sacred oath they made when having their children baptized and that they would raise them in the practice of the Catholic Faith. Many things will strive to compete with making God first in your lives. Even at

this young age, simply not going to Mass, sports, language lessons, music lessons, social events. Many things will compete for your time. Parents need to "fight" to keep God first, to give God love and adoration first and for a Catholic this means many things, the first of which is attending Mass and bringing your children with you on Sunday, every Sunday. Remember, God calls us to keep the Sabbath holy; the Church teaches us that we are required to attend Mass on Sundays. We need this weekly check-in with God, to hear his Word and if possible to receive him in Holy Communion every 7 days.

Make this time, carve out this time, be intentional about dedicating this time for God and you'll have the time to do what needs to be done for your children and family. The Lord calls us to trust him. He never lets us down!

Our 10 Year Vision is being blessed by God because people are praying, and prayer is always the first ingredient to fruitfulness, and opening themselves to be the Lord's instruments, working and working hard. Our ministries, initiatives are being aligned to the Four Core Values of: 1) Evangelical Hospitality; 2) Rooted in Tradition; 3) Engaged Disciples and 4) Multiplying Leaders. Of these Four Core Values, it is Multiplying Leaders that, I believe, is the most important. This is the only way to ensure that leaders are identified, raised up, supported, and then train others to be leaders. This is how we are going to drill this Vision down to bedrock and then keep it going and going and going.

Let us keep each other in prayer, *Fr. Hamilton*

復活期第三主日 本堂神父的話



『我在你面前呈現大地上最偉大的事物:聖體聖事。』——J.R.R.托爾金。托爾金不僅是有史以來偉大的故事作家之一,而且是一位虔誠的天主教徒,對聖體奇蹟中耶穌基督的真實臨在擁有堅定、深刻和個人的信仰。

在這個四月份,我們在天主教的曆法中 專注於聖體奇跡,你可能預期的是一位聖人 的引言,或者一個教理問答的參考,但這位 著名的《魔戒》和《霍比特人》的作者所說 的話,聖人們都會同意。

與其崇拜偶像,讓我們來朝拜並尊崇聖 體奇跡中的耶穌基督。在這個月裡,我們也 慶祝了神聖慈悲主日,並繼續渡過復活季 節,直至耶穌升天的五月。祂在聖體奇跡中 真實地臨在,我們也被聖神環繞。

如果你尚未完全接受聖體奇跡是耶穌基 督的真實臨在,祂的身體和血,也許可以閱 讀相關資料,並祈求天主的指引,幫助你克 服對祂的懷疑。

在這四月份,我要求大家為我們教區的 二年級學生祈禱,他們將於4月27日星期六 上午9:00初領聖體。在那天早上將不會有 8:00彌撒。我會再次重複這個消息。教堂將在 那天早上擠滿人,因為我們學校和教理預備 班大約有75名二年級學生參加。

非常重要的是,我們要為這些孩子的父 母祈禱!祈求他們信守當初給孩子領洗時所 做的神聖誓言,並且將他們培育成為忠實實 踐天主教信仰的人。世上許多事物都會竭力 跟天主競爭要作生活中首要的地位。即使在 這個年幼的階段,也會有許多事物競爭著你的時間,例如不去參加彌撒、而去參加體育活動、語言課程、音樂課程、社交活動等。 父母需要「奮鬥」來讓天主始終保持首位, 首先要給天主予愛和朝拜,而對於一位天主 教徒來說,這意味著許多事情,其中最重要 的是每週日都要參加彌撒,並且帶著孩子一 起參加。請記住,天主呼召我們將安息日視 為神聖的;教會教導我們星期日必須參與彌 撒。我們需要每週與天主接觸,去聆聽祂的 聖言,並且如果可能的話,每7天領受一次聖 體聖事。

把這段時間刻意為天主預留下來,有意 識地將這段時間奉獻給天主,你就定會有時 間為你的孩子和家庭做必須要做的事情。主 呼召我們要信任祂。祂從不讓我們失望!

我們的十年願景因著人們的祈禱而得蒙 天主的祝福,祈禱始終是結果豐富的第一要 素,並且願意成為主的工具,勤奮地工作。 我們的事工和倡議正在對四個核心價值進行 調整:1)殷勤福傳之道;2)植根於傳統; 3)投入的門徒;4)培育領袖。在這四個核 心價值中,我相信,最重要的是培育領袖。 這是確保領袖被識別、培養、支持,然後訓 練其他人成為領袖的唯一方式。這是我們將 這個願景深入挖掘到基石,然後不斷發展和 延續的方法。



Some of St. Thomas Aquinas' most beautiful quotes

St. Thomas Aquinas was a brilliant philosopher and theologian, and is a doctor of the Church. Even today, his writings speak powerfully to us.

St. <u>Thomas Aquinas</u> deserves the term "angelic" doctor for more than one reason. This Italian friar and preacher, proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 1567 by Pope Pius V, was renowned for his purity—Leo XIII emphasizes his "perfect integrity of morals"—and his luminous intelligence. In his motu proprio *Doctoris Angelici*, Pope Pius X refers to "the almost angelic quality of his intellect." Here we offer you an anthology of striking and inspiring quotations, taken from the *Summa Theologiae*, the *Summa Contra Gentiles*, and the *Catechetical Sermons on the Apostles' Creed*, which wonderfully reflect the clarity of his soul.

Love is the perfection of Christian life

"A thing is said to be perfect in so far as it attains its proper end, which is the ultimate perfection thereof. Now it is charity that unites us to God, Who is the last end of the human mind, since "he that abideth in charity abideth in God, and God in him" (1 Jn. 4:16). Therefore the perfection of the Christian life consists radically in charity." (Summa Theologiae II-II, q.184, a.1, co)

It is better to enlighten than to merely shine

"For even as it is better to enlighten than merely to shine, so is it better to give to others the fruits of one's contemplation than merely to contemplate." (Summa Theologiae IIa-IIae, q.188, a.6, co)

We need God's grace to lift us up to him

"Human nature stands in need of the gratuitous will of God in order to be lifted up to God, since this is above its natural capability." (Summa Theologiae III q.2, a.10, resp)

Spiritual perfection is for all ages

"Now the soul, to which spiritual birth and perfect spiritual age belong, is immortal; and just as it can in old age attain to spiritual birth, so can it attain to perfect (spiritual) age in youth or childhood; because the various ages of the body do not affect the soul." (Summa Theologiae III, q.72, a.8, co)

Laughter is essential to being human

"Man cannot be without having the faculty of laughing." (Summa Theologiae I, q.44, a.1, ad 1)

Christ was tempted for our sake

"Christ wished to be tempted; first that He might strengthen us against temptations. (...) Secondly, that we might be warned, so that none, however holy, may think himself safe or free from temptation. (...) Thirdly, in order to give us an example: to teach us, to wit, how to overcome the temptations of the devil. (...) Fourthly, in order to fill us with confidence in His mercy." (Summa Theologiae III, q.41, a.1, resp)

Faith requires good will

"The intellect is moved by the command of the will to assent to what is of faith: for 'no man believeth, unless he will." (Summa Theologiae, I-II, q.56, a.3, co)

Only God can satisfy us

"It is evident that naught can lull man's will, save the universal good. This is to be found, not in any creature, but in God alone; because every creature has goodness by participation. Wherefore God alone can satisfy the will of man (...). Therefore God alone constitutes man's happiness." (Summa Theologiae I-II, q.2, a.8, co)


Nothing God has created is evil in itself

"Nothing tends toward its contrary, for each thing inclines to what is like and suitable to itself. Now, every being seeks a good, when it is acting, as has been proved. Therefore, no being, inasmuch as being, is evil." (Summa contra Gentiles III,7)

The four effects of faith

"Faith brings about four good effects. The first is that through faith the soul is united to God. (...) The second effect of faith is that eternal life is already begun in us; for eternal life is nothing else than knowing God. (...) The third good that comes from faith is that right direction which it gives to our present life. (...) The fourth effect of faith is that by it we overcome temptations." (Sermon on the Apostles' Creed)
