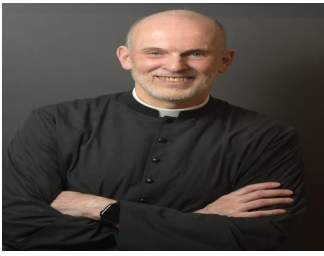

## Second Sunday of Lent The Transfiguration



This Sunday, we stand with Peter, James, and John on Mount Tabor as Jesus is transfigured before them (cf. Matthew 17:1-9). In the midst of Lent, a season of repentance, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, the Church gives us this moment of glory. Why? Because Lent is not about darkness alone. It is about transformation. It is about becoming radiant with Christ.

I want to share with you two radiant moments in the life of our parish this past week.

### The Right of Election – A Mountaintop Moment

Last week, at the Cathedral, Archbishop Smith celebrated the **Rite of Election**. Our candidates, accompanied by their sponsors and coordinators, stood publicly and declared their desire to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter

What a moment of grace.

I want to express my deep gratitude:

This is not accidental growth.

It is the fruit of our **Discipleship Pathway**:

**Alpha → Faith Studies → RCIA → (in the nearest future possible) Life Groups**

The next step, as I have mentioned before, will be the expansion of **Life Groups**, smaller communities where people continue to grow, connect, and deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ and with one another.

There is no limit to how deeply we can know Christ and there is no limit to the human longing for authentic connection.

This is exactly what our 10-Year Vision is about. Not buildings first. Not programs first, but people, brought into relationship with Jesus Christ and with one another.

Like the Transfiguration, these moments allow us to glimpse what God is doing among us.

### A New Chapter – Welcoming Catherine Kriekenbeek-Lee

The second great blessing is one that is truly historic.

After many conversations between myself and Fr. Justin Wong of St. Anthony's Parish, something beautiful has emerged.

St. Anthony's has been deeply engaged in parish renewal for many years. Their culture of leadership, discipleship, and mission has grown wide and deep and now, they are at a place where they desire to assist other parishes in renewal.

For the first time in the Archdiocese of Vancouver, this desire is taking concrete form.

Beginning in March, **Catherine Kriekenbeek-Lee**, office manager at St. Anthony's and a key leader in their renewal journey, will be working with us:

- One full day per week starting in March
- Two full days per week by the end of March

She will assist us in advancing our **10-Year Vision**, supporting our discipleship efforts, strengthening our welcoming culture, and helping us continue building systems that foster growth and mission.

Catherine has walked this road alongside Fr. Justin and his team for many years. She brings wisdom, practical experience, humility, and a deep love for the Church and so I want to express sincere gratitude:

- To God, who opens doors we could never engineer
- To Fr. Justin and the leadership team of St. Anthony's
- To their Finance Council and parish community for their generosity
- and to Catherine herself, for her willingness to serve beyond her own parish

She will begin attending Mass here, likely the 9:00am Sunday Mass, simply to meet parishioners and begin building relationships. When you see her, please welcome her warmly.

So many real, concrete reasons to give thanks!
