Wanted - Used Eyeglasses


The Corpus Christi Seniors' Ministry is collecting used eyeglasses for Third World Eye Care Society (TWECS).



BEGINS ASH WEDNESDAY, FEB 14th



pastor's Corner

6th Sunday of Ordinary Time

As if you did not know by now, the season of Lent begins this Wednesday with Ash Wednesday. There are plenty of Masses to attend – 9am, 4pm and 7pm. It is a very good way to begin this important season in our lives as Catholics. Lent, as you know, is 40 days in length (if you count from Ash Wednesday through to Holy Saturday and take out the Sundays, because each Sunday is like Easter day and is therefore not a day of penance, you then have 40 days).

This commemorates the 40 days that Our Lord spent in the desert fasting and praying and then engaging in spiritual warfare with Satan, to show us how to deal with temptation. Realizing this, we should be able to see Lent as kind of a 40 day retreat with Jesus ... accompanying him through his time in the desert ... even while we remain in the middle of the world.

We begin Lent with this important reminder: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are required days of <u>Fast</u> <u>and Abstinence</u>. This derives from Jesus's teaching that unless we do penance we will perish. So doing penance is not an option for any of us. Here is what Canon Law teaches us:

Canon 1250 All Fridays through the year and the time of Lent are penitential days and times throughout the entire Church.

Canon 1251 Abstinence from eating meat or another food according to the prescriptions of the conference of bishops is to be observed on Fridays throughout the year unless they are solemnities; abstinence and fast are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on the Friday of the Passion and Death of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Canon 1252 All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence; all adults are bound by the law of fast up to the beginning of their sixtieth year. Nevertheless, pastors and parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance. What in specific terms does it mean to **abstain**? It means that we are to refrain from flesh meat. We do this in order to offer reparation for the human flesh of Christ being pierced on the cross. If you are vegetarian abstain from your favorite vegetable, or non-meat food.

Fasting means that your largest meal is reduced by ½ and keep the other two meals the same. Do not snack in between meals, unless you need to for medical reasons. Again, the important thing here is that we need to do penance. Jesus doesn't ask us to harm ourselves, or do something incredibly difficult. We need to offer reparation for our sins, to unite ourselves to the suffering of Christ and to pray for the good of others. Put a post-it note somewhere to remind yourself – fast and abstain on Ash Wednesday.

I will just finish this by mentioning that the Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday night after the 6pm Holy Hour during Lent, except on a 1st Friday when they are prayed after the 7pm Mass. Try to attend one if not more throughout the season. More to come in the next PC.



常年期第五主日 本堂神父的話

假如你還沒注意,本星期三已是「聖灰瞻禮」,本年度的「四旬期」開始;我們當天會有上午九時、下午四時及七時的彌撒,供大家參與,也是天主教信眾進入重要禮儀年期的最好方法。

須知道,「四旬期」是從「聖灰瞻禮日」 算起,除去當中的主日(因為主日是紀念基督 復活的喜樂慶日),直至復活節前夕,共有四 十天之久。這四十天,是紀念吾主在曠野守嚴 齋及祈禱,又曾對抗魔鬼,給我們豎立如何抵 抗誘惑的榜樣。按此,我們可以把「四旬期」 看做和主耶穌共渡退省的時刻——在俗世中與 祂在曠野裡一起渡過。

「四旬期」特別提醒我們,適齡教友必須在「聖灰瞻禮」及「苦難日」守大小齋!因為耶穌教導我們,必須做補贖,否則會喪亡。 「做補贖」並非教友的選項,而是「必須」 的。聖教法典指出:

#1250 在普世教會內,補贖日期和時間為全年的每週星期五和四旬期。

#1251 全年每週五應守小齋,不食 肉類,或主教團所規定的其它食物,但星期五 遇到節日不在此限;聖灰禮儀星期三,及吾主 耶穌基督死難日星期五則應守大齋及小齋。

#1252 凡滿十四歲者應遵守小齋 法;凡成年人而未到六十歲者應遵守大齋法, 但因年齡幼小而不受大小齋法約束者,人靈的 牧者及父母應設法培養他們補贖的真精神。 「小齋」又是什麼意思呢?是指克制、避免進食動物的肉,用以彌補基督肉身在聖架上被刺透的苦。如果你早已食素,則可克制進食喜愛的素食。

「大齋」一天三餐只吃平常份量的一半, 不吃零食——除了因服藥需要另外進食。

「齋戒」最重要的意念是「補贖」。耶穌無意要我們傷害自己,或要做極其嚴苛的克苦。我們只需彌補自己的罪孽,與苦難中的基督結合,並為別人的靈益祈禱。嘗試在當眼的地方,貼上在「聖灰瞻禮」和「苦難日」克守大小齋的提示。

「四旬期」內每週星期五下午六時聖時祈 禱後,我們會有拜苦路善功。
