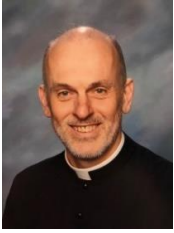

pastor's Corner

5th Sunday of Easter Pastor's Corner

As I write this Pastor's Corner I am about to begin the second day of the Alpha Conference in London, England. The first day was electric! There are 5,000 Christians (Catholic, Protestants, Orthodox) from all over the world who have come to London, England to experience the Visioning of Nicky Gumbel (the founder of Alpha) who is calling us to "keep our eyes looking up and out." Nicky is planning a 10 Year Vision to prepare for April 2033, which is the 2000th anniversary of the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. She wants to make the word of God available to every person on the planet. This is possible not only through the paper version, but also through the electronic version. I myself have a bible on my iPad and read/pray it every day!

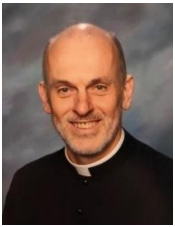
All of us Catholics should be reading the word of God every day. Did you know that just by reading the Readings of Mass over a three-year period you will read 13.5 percent of the Old Testament, not counting the Psalms; 54.9 percent of the non-Gospel New Testament; 89.8 percent of the Gospels and 71.5 percent of the entire New Testament? If you read the New Testament three minutes each day you will read 18.5 hours in a year. Did you know that? More importantly, when you read the word of God, or Sacred Scripture, you will be spiritually nourished and strengthened in your relationship with God and also gain a perspective on the world that we all need – God's perspective.

The Alpha Conference is also about Alpha. Alpha is a "mechanism" or "instrument" that brings people to an encounter with Jesus Christ. I have heard some profound stories about real people whose whole lives have been touched and turned around and heavenward, because of their taking Alpha. Obviously it is Jesus Christ who really changes a heart, or a life, but Jesus also expects you and me to be his active instruments.

At Corpus Christi, lives are also being changed because of Alpha and it is only beginning! Alpha is a vital part of our 10 Year Vision which is our bold picture of a preferred future. I want people to have an encounter with Jesus Christ; I desire people to know the love of Christ and his life-changing power and love; I desire people to know that Jesus and only Jesus has the answers to life.

Let us give a lot of thanks that God has helped us bring this 10 Year Vision to reality and that lives are being changed as they encounter Jesus Christ in his holy Catholic Church.

復活期第五主日

本堂神父的話

當我寫這個本堂神父的話時，我即將開始在英國倫敦舉行的啟發會議的第二天。第一天是震悚的！來自世界各地的 5000 名基督徒（天主教徒、新教徒、東正教）來到英國倫敦，體驗 Nicky Gumbel（啟發的創始人）的願景，他呼籲我們『保持眼睛向上和向外』。" Nicky 正在計劃一個 10 年願景，為 2033 年 4 月做準備，這是耶穌基督從死裡復活 2000 周年。她想讓地球上的每個人都能聽到天主的話語。這不僅可以通過紙質版本實現，還可以通過電子版本實現。我自己在我的 iPad 上有一本聖經，每天都閱讀/祈禱！

我們所有天主教徒都應該每天閱讀天主的話語。你知道嗎，僅僅在三年內閱讀彌撒讀物，你就會讀舊約的 13.5%，這還不包括詩篇；54.9%的非福音新約；89.8%的福音書和 71.5%的新約？如果你每天讀三分鐘新約，你一年就會讀 18.5 個小時。你可知道嗎？更重要的是，當你閱讀天主的話語或聖經時，你會在與天主的關係中得到屬靈的滋養和堅強，並獲得我們都需要的世界觀點——天主的觀點。

這啟發的會議是有關啟發活動的。啟發是一種“機制”或“工具”，它帶人們與耶穌基督相遇。我聽過一些關於真實人物的深刻故事，他們的一生都被觸動了，轉過身來，走向天堂，因為他們接受了啟發。顯然，耶穌基督真正改變了一顆心或一個生命，但耶穌也期望你和我成為祂活躍的工具。

在基督聖體聖血堂，生活也因為啟發活動而改變，而這才剛剛開始！啟發是我們 10 年願景的重要組成部分，這是我們對期望的未來的大胆描繪。我希望人們與耶穌基督相遇；我希望人們知道基督的愛以及祂改變生命的能力和愛；我希望人們知道耶穌，只有耶穌有生命的答案。

讓我們非常感謝天主幫助我們實現這個 10 年願景，當人們在神聖的天主教會遇到了耶穌基督，他們生活便正在改變。
