pastor's Corner

Ascension Sunday



As the month of May just ended yesterday, May 31st, I think it is a good and important thing to remind people of some of the many blessings this parish has experienced in May. On May 3rd, I had the privilege of baptizing 21 children of the parents that were baptized at the Easter Vigil. The week previous to that, our parish celebrated 1st Holy Communion with 75 children of our School/PREP. Previous to their reception of 1st Holy Communion, they received Jesus for the 1st time in the sacrament of Penance, or Confession.

Then on May 10th, I conferred the sacrament of Confirmation on 66 students of our School/PREP. Then on May 17th, I completed our RCIA program for 2025 by baptizing Rachel Chan into the Catholic Church.

Rachel Chan's Sacraments of Initiation Novena to the Holy Spirit

With so many graces it is easy to miss, or quickly forget what God is doing in our parish. He is not only pouring out his divine life to these children and adults; God is also calling us to live out our baptism; to be faithful to our baptismal promises; to ensure the children are raised in the faith and to live out our confirmation, to be soldiers of Jesus Christ; to be faithful to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and to frequent the sacrament of

Penance. This is the most underrated sacrament, in my accumulated experience.

Today we celebrate the great Feast of the Ascension. St. Thomas Aquinas taught that the Ascension of Jesus is important for four key reasons:

- 1. **Increases our faith** Christ's bodily absence challenges us to trust more deeply in God's promises.
- 2. **Lifts our hope** Jesus ascended to prepare a place for us, drawing our hearts toward heaven.
- 3. **Strengthens our charity** By sending the Holy Spirit after ascending, Christ empowers us to love.
- 4. **Confirms Christ's exaltation** His return to the Father reveals His full divinity and glorification.

pastor's Corner

耶穌升天主日 本堂神父的話



昨日,五月三十一日,是五月的最後一天。值此機會,我認為有必要也非常值得提醒大家,我們堂區在五月份所蒙受的眾多恩寵與祝福。在五月三日,我有幸為那些在復活前夕守夜禮中領受聖洗的父母們的二十一位孩子施行聖洗聖事。就在那之前的一週,我們堂區為學校及道理班的七十五位孩子舉行了初領聖體大典。孩子們在初領聖體之前,也首次在修和聖事中領受了耶穌的寬恕與愛。

接著,在五月十日,我為學校及要道班的六十六位學生施行了堅振聖事。然後在五月十七日,我為 2025 年的成人慕道團(RCIA)課程畫下句點,並為 Rachel Chan 施行入門聖事,使她正式進入天主教會。

Rachel Chan 的入門聖事 向聖神的九日敬禮

天主賜下這麼多的恩寵,往往令人難以悉 數,甚至容易忽略或迅速遺忘祂在我們堂區 內所成就的事。天主不僅將祂的生命傾注於 這些兒童與成人身上,祂也召叫我們每一位 要活出我們的聖洗聖召,忠於我們在聖洗中 所立的盟約;要確保孩子們在信仰中成長; 要活出堅振聖事的精神,成為基督的精兵; 並在聖體聖事中忠於耶穌,常常領受修和聖 事。根據我多年牧靈的經驗,修和聖事是所 有聖事中最被忽略的一項。

今天,我們慶祝光榮的耶穌升天節。聖多瑪斯·阿奎納教導我們,耶穌升天的奧蹟有四個重要的意義:

- 1. **增強信德** —— 基督肉身的離去,挑戰我們更加信賴天主的許諾;
- 2. **提昇望德** —— 耶穌升天是為我們預備地方,吸引我們的心志歸向天鄉;
- 3. **激發愛德** —— 基督升天後派遣聖神,賜 我們愛人的能力;
- 確證基督的光榮 —— 祂返回父的懷抱, 彰顯祂完全的天主性與光榮。

Establishing a daily routine like this can help turn your everyday worries into spiritual strength!

2) Challenge Your Mindset

Overcoming anxiety starts with changing how you think. Hart explains, "Dale Carnegie said, 'The most

important thing is the value of what we think. If I know what you think, I know who you are.' The biggest challenge I think we all have: our lives are what our thoughts make it."

By choosing faithful affirmations over negativity, you can effectively combat anxieties and grow deeper confidence rooted in Catholic teaching.

3) Redefine Failure with Faith

Anxiety often arises from a fear of failure, but what if you saw failure through God's eyes?

"If failure is, 'I tried to do this and I didn't achieve the result,' we're going to fail all the time. That's not necessarily a bad thing. What can I learn from this? This is all part of God and the experience of equipping me to deal with things and to grow."

Hart says joyfully embracing this perspective changes setbacks into steps toward spiritual growth.

The gentlemen say that putting these principles into practice will transform your anxiety into authentic confidence!


