









Pastor's Corner

2nd Sunday of Easter Mercy Sunday



Two weeks ago we celebrated the three holiest days in the Church year: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. I have already thanked everyone for the many ways the Sacred Liturgy was carried out so well, to God's honour and glory.

I want to highlight that for the past three years we have been living out our 10 Year Vision. One of the aspects of this Vision is to establish a new discipleship pathway for those desiring to begin the journey of becoming Catholic, but also for those Catholics who desire to deepen their friendship with Jesus Christ and his Church.

At the Easter Vigil we experienced the 1st fruits of our Vision when 18 adults received the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist. One adult was received into Full Communion with the Church. One adult was unable to make the Vigil due to illness so they will be received soon. Nineteen (19) adults were received into the Church, our Corpus Christi family. We have so much to give thanks to God for! God wants to continue blessing our parish and the Vision that we are striving for, that preferred picture of the future. Please continue to pray and ask God for this growth!

Fr. Salvino and I heard Confessions for 3.5 hours (each) after the Mass of the Lord's Supper. We were both exhausted when it was completed, but exhausted in the best of ways. It was an excellent way to celebrate the gift of the Priesthood and the Holy Eucharist. THEN, on Holy Saturday morning, we heard Confessions for 2.5 hours (each). This is a great blessing given to us by God. Have you ever thought of it this way? You should!!!


Fr. Salvino will be away from the parish for 4-6 weeks for hernia surgery. He will be staying with his parents, but is excited to return to the parish ASAP!

Today we celebrate the beautiful Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday. This devotion and Feast began with Sister Faustina, but reached the world through the Pontificate of St. Pope John Paul II. Whether you know much about the devotion or not, I think everyone gets the point. We all need God's mercy; we all want God's mercy. To receive God's mercy is not God forgetting our sins as if they did not matter, but rather God's mercy is a hope that all is never lost and if we turn to God and repent. If we do this he will forgive our sin(s). God will not harm us, or crush us, or hurt us. God will forgive us, heal us and elevate us to be his children!

God will extend his mercy to us, and God will purify us of the sin that clings to us and holds us back from loving him and others around us. This "purifying" does hurt a little, but the outcome is wonderful, the true freedom of the children of God, restored friendship with the Lord and perhaps with others around us. This last reality is a little trickier as we might be ready to forgive another, or be forgiven by another, but that other person may not be ready for reconciliation with us. Remember this short prayer, if nothing else: "Jesus, I trust in You!"

pastor's Corner

復活期第二主日 慈悲主日 本堂神父的說



兩週前,我們慶祝了教會一年中最神聖的三天:聖週四、受難週五和復活節守夜。 我已經感謝大家以許多出色的方法讓這些禮 儀完美地舉行,光榮和榮耀了天主。

我想強調過去三年來我們一直在實踐我們的十年願景。這個願景的一個方面是為那些希望開始成為天主教徒的人建立一條新的門徒之路,同時也為那些希望加深與耶穌基督及其教會的友誼的天主教徒們建立這條路徑。

在復活節守夜,我們體驗到了我們願景的初果,有 18 名成年人領受了洗禮、堅振和聖體的聖事。另有一位成年人被接納進入教會的完全共融。由於疾病,有一位成年人未能參加守夜彌撒,但他們將很快會被接納。共有 19 位成年人被接納進入教會,成為我們基督聖體聖血堂家庭的一員。我們有很多值得感謝天主的事情!天主希望繼續祝福我們的堂區和我們努力追求的願景,那個未來的理想景象。請繼續祈禱,向天主祈求這種增長!

Salvino 神父和我在最後晚餐彌撒後每人聽了 3.5 個小時的告解。當完成時,我們都筋疲力盡,但這種疲憊是最好的。這是慶祝得蒙司祭職位的恩典和聖體的絕佳方式。接著,在聖週六上午,我們每人又聽了 2.5 個小時的告解。這是天主賜給我們的一個偉大恩典。你有沒有想過這樣呢?你應該!!!

Salvino 神父將因小腸氣手術離開堂 區 4-6 週。他將與父母同住,但他迫不及待 地希望盡快返回堂區!

今天我們慶祝美麗的慈悲主日節。這個 虔誠和節日始於傅天娜修女,通過教宗聖若 望保祿二世的推廣而傳遍了世界。無論你對 這個敬禮有多少了解,我想每個人都能理解 它的意義。我們都需要天主的慈悲;我們都 渴望天主的慈悲。獲得天主的慈悲並不是天 主忘記我們的罪過,好像它們無關重要一 樣,而是天主的慈悲給予了希望,即使一切 似乎已經失去,如果我們轉向天主並作懺 悔,祂將原諒我們的罪過。天主不會危害我 們,壓垮我們或傷害我們。天主會寬恕我 們,醫治我們,提升我們成為祂的兒女!

天主會向我們延展祂的慈悲,並潔淨我們身上纏繞的罪惡,使我們能夠愛祂和我們問圍的人。這種『潔淨』可能會讓我們感到有些痛苦,但結果是美好的,那就是天主子女真正的自由,與主和問圍的人恢復友誼。最後這一點有些棘手,因為我們可能已經準備好原諒別人,或者被別人原諒了,但對方可能尚未準備好與我們和解。如果什麼來不了,請記住這個簡短的祈禱:『耶穌,我信賴你!』

The Feast of the Divine Mercy 4 Key Points

- Saint Faustina Kowalska was a Polish nun who received mystical revelations in which Jesus showed her his heart, the source of mercy and expressed his wish that this feast was celebrated. Therefore, she is known as the messenger of Divine Mercy.
- The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued on May 23, 2000 a decree (at the suggestion of St. John Paul II) in which the feast of Divine Mercy would be celebrated each year on the second Sunday of Easter.
- 3. In order to celebrate this day, it is recommended to pray the Chaplet and the Novena of the Divine Mercy, go to confession (after a deep examination of conscience), and to receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast of Divine Mercy.
- 4. The main purpose of the Feast of the Divine Mercy is to send the entire world an important message: God is merciful and He loves us all.

How to Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet

Begin By Holding Your Rosary

We start the chaplet by making the sign of the Cross: *In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, Amen.*

Then we continue with an Our Father, a Hail Mary, and the Creed using the first three beads of the rosary.

The Large Bead

On the bigger bead, where we usually pray the Our Father, we say the following prayer:

"Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world".

The Following Beads

On the following beads, where we usually pray the Hail Mary, we say the following prayer: "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world". We repeat this pattern of prayer throughout the five decades of the rosary.


At the End of Your Rosary Beads

When we finish the five decades of the rosary with the prayers we've mentioned above, we say the following final prayer three times:

"Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world."

As with every prayer, we end with the Divine Mercy Chaplet with the sign of the Cross: *In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, Amen.*
