pastor's Corner

Christ the King



We are still in the month of November. The Church calendar is a kind of catechesis in that it teaches us different aspects or truths of our faith. The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in purgatory. It is important that we pray for them, teach the children to pray for them and offer prayers and suffrages for them. Here are some powerful prayers for the souls in purgatory:

8 Powerful Prayers for the Poor Souls

For the four weeks I have written about what a team from Corpus Christi learned from travelling to Detroit, the headquarters of ACTS XXIX (Fr. John Ricarrrdo and his team). I am including here all 4 sections that I put together. I believe there is something here for everyone to benefit from. Read it and give it a try, implement something of what is contained here into your life.

Immersive

Jesus Christ is a King: ***"You say that I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I came into the world, to bear witness to the truth" (Jn 18:37).*** But his Kingdom is not of this world; he is not here to run a government. Jesus is not a King who has rivals, or better put, he is not in competition with anyone, or anything. Jesus is a King, but he is also the King of kings and the Lord of lords!

To be with Jesus is to be on the winning side of life; to be with Jesus is to be assured of victory; to be with Jesus is to know that he can and will defeat any enemy we have, the enemies within ourselves and the enemies outside of us.

Jesus has come here, as the Preface of Mass teaches us, **to bring us an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice and peace.** This is not wishful thinking. You and I are called to be disciples who witness to our Lord's life and teaching.

Advent begins next Sunday, are you thinking ahead? Be intentional about preparing for the birth of Jesus. How can we do this? I will elaborate more in the coming weeks, but for now here are few things:

- 1) Think now: what is some area in your life that you can I improve in? It could be something as simple as cleaning up after yourself, or putting things away, or cleaning up your language. Make a resolution with Gods' help to improve in one (1) area. We can all do a lot of good by starting small and working on it every day!
- 2) Make a plan; follow the SMART approach (specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, timely), to pray more. Start with 10, or 15 minutes of prayer. Stick to it no matter how many times you fail. If you, or when you "fail" then fail forward, try again!

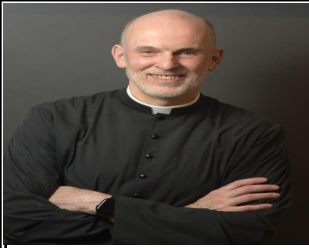

pastor's Corner

基督普世君王節 本堂神父的話



我們仍處於十一月份。整個禮儀曆本身就是一種要理教育，因為它教導我們信仰中的不同層面與真理。十一月是奉獻給在煉獄中的諸煉靈的月份。為他們祈禱、教導兒童為他們祈禱，以及為他們奉獻祈禱與補贖，都是重要的。以下是一些為煉靈祈禱的有力經文：

8 Powerful Prayers for the Poor Souls

在過去四週中，我撰寫了有關聖體聖血堂一個團隊前往美國底特律市——ACTS XXIX（由若望·李卡多神父及其團隊領導）的總部——所學到的內容。現在我把先前整理的四個部分全部收錄在此。我相信其中一定有能使每一位受益的地方。請閱讀並試著實行，把其中的一些內容落實在你的生活當中。

Immersive

耶穌基督是君王：「你說的是，我是君王。我為此而生，我也為此而來到世界上，為給真理作證。」（若18:37）但他的王國並不屬於這世界；他不是來治理一個世俗政權的。耶穌不是一位有對手的君王，更準確地說，他不與任何人或任何事競爭。耶穌確實是君王，而且是萬王之王、萬主之主！

與耶穌同在，就是站在生命勝利的一方；與耶穌同在，就有勝利的確據；與耶穌同在，就知道他能並且必定會戰勝我們的一切敵人——不論是內在的，還是外在的。

正如彌撒〈頌謝詞〉教導我們的，耶穌來到世上，是要帶給我們一個永恆而普世的國度：真理與生命的國度、聖潔與恩寵的國度、公義與平安的國度。這並非幻想，而是事實。你和我都被召叫成為門徒，為主的生命與教導作見證。

將臨期下主日就要開始了——你是否已經開始預備？請有意識、有計畫地為迎接耶穌的誕生做準備。該如何做呢？我會在未來幾週詳細說明，但目前先提供幾個方向：

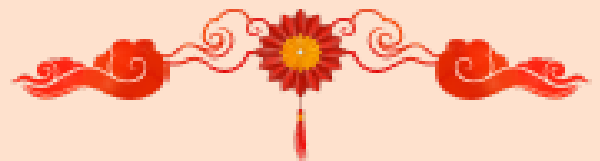
1. 現在就想一想：你生命中有哪些領域可以改進？

可能是一些很簡單的事，例如：自己使用完的東西自己收拾，把物品放回原位，或是改進自己的用語。求天主助佑，在某一個具體領域立下決心並努力改進。由小處著手，每天實踐，我們都能累積許多善工！

2. 做一份計畫；按照「S.M.A.R.T.」原則（具體的、可衡量的、可達成的、實際的、有時限的）來增加祈禱的時間。

先從十或十五分鐘祈禱開始。不論失敗多少次，都要堅持下去。如果你「失敗」了，就失敗中學習，再重新開始！
