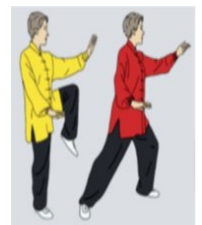

pastor's Corner

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time



The **General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) 58–60** confirms that the proper solemnity of a parish (dedication, or anniversary) is celebrated in place of the Sunday of Ordinary Time within that parish. Our Parish anniversary date of Dedication, when our parish was consecrated for Divine Worship, is October 10th. With this in mind, we will celebrate the Anniversary of the Dedication of the Church, Corpus Christi, on October 12th. The Mass Readings and homily will reflect this and there will be printed versions of the Readings to assist you in following them during Mass, or even better – praying them before Mass begins.

On Monday, September 29th, we celebrated the Feast of the Archangels. This is a very good short article on [Angels](#).

Fr. Patrick and I will be joining a group of leaders from this parish, as well as the Archdiocese of Vancouver, in Detroit, Michigan to be with Fr. John Riccardo and a program that ACTS XXIX offers called *Immersive*. Our week will consist of the following: **“teaching and preaching, personal prayer, group prayer discernment, discussion, fellowship and hospitality.”**

Please keep this week of *Immersive* in your prayer. During our absence Fr. Hoo, O.P. will be celebrating Mass here at Corpus Christi and Jerome will be present as well.

Two weeks ago, my homily was aimed to help people know what it looks like to change the view of our day/life by looking upward. Here is a link to the homily and below are the 2 simple action items to try and practice: [Looking Upwards II](#). We all need to resist the gravitational pull to go inwards, to think of oneself, and look upwards and then outwards.

Here are two simple practices for this week:

1) Pause Daily to Look Upward

Before you touch your phone in the morning, pause and pray:

Lord, open my eyes to You and to others today.

One sentence. It shifts your gaze upward before the day pulls you inward.

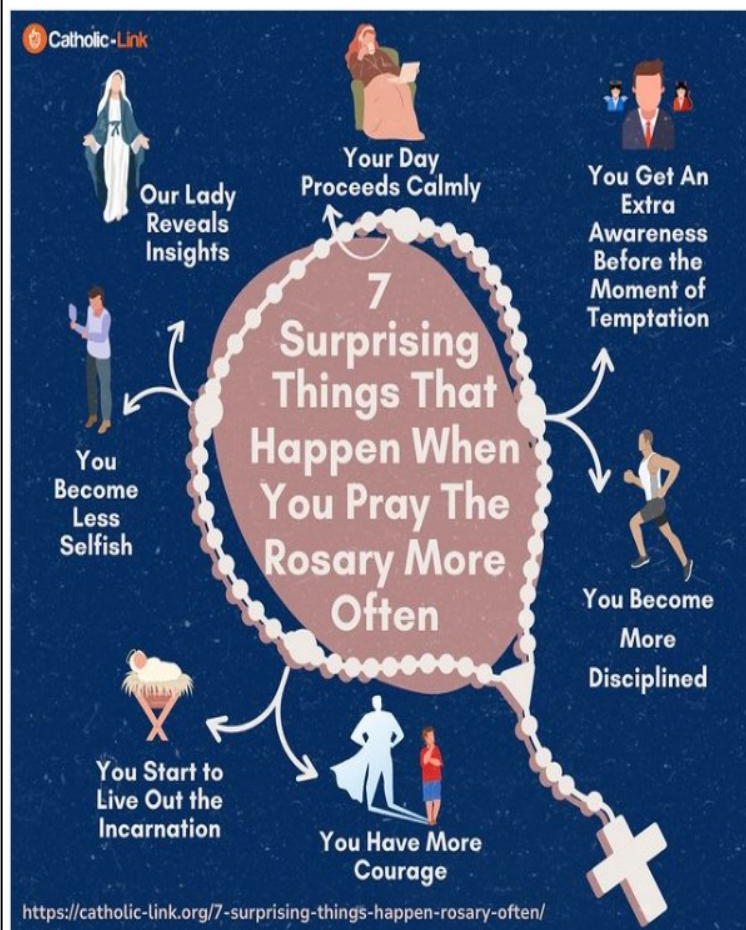
2) Notice One Lazarus in your life

Each day ask: “Who is at my gate?”

It might be a co-worker who feels invisible, a classmate no one sits with, a neighbor who is isolated, or a family member is carrying a silent burden.

These are not heroic acts. They are daily habits. Habits that train the heart to resist the pull to go inwards by looking upward to Jesus who will then have us look outward to those around us.

常年期第二十七主日 本堂神父的話



《羅馬彌撒經書總論》第58至60條指出，堂區的專屬慶典（如祝聖日或週年紀念）可取代當週的常年期主日慶典。在我們堂區，聖堂的祝聖日是10月10日。鑑於此，我們將於10月12日慶祝聖體堂的祝聖週年紀念。當日的彌撒讀經與講道將圍繞此主題，並備有印刷版讀經，方便大家在彌撒中跟隨，或更好地在彌撒前先行祈禱。

9月29日（星期一），我們慶祝了總領天使的慶日。以下是一篇關於天使們的簡短好文，[Angels](#)，值得一讀。

我與Patrick神父將與本堂及溫哥華總教區的領袖們一同前往美國密西根州底特律，參加由 Fr. John Riccardo 和 ACTS XXIX 所舉辦的「Immersive」培育課程。這一週的內容包括：「教導與講道、個人祈禱、團體辨明、討論、夥伴與款待」。

懇請大家為我們這週的培育課程代禱。在我們離開期間，Hoo神父（道明會）將在聖體堂主持彌撒，Jerome 也會在場協助。

兩週前，我的講道旨在幫助大家學習如何轉變每日/生命的視角——由向內轉為向上仰望。以下是講道連結與兩項簡單的實踐建議：[Looking Upwards II](#)〈向上仰望 II〉。我們

都需要抗拒那股向內的引力，學習仰望天主，然後向外關懷他人。

本週的兩項簡單操練：

1. 每日暫停，向上仰望

早上在碰手機之前，先停下來祈禱一句：
主啊，請開啟我今天看見祢與他人的眼睛。

一句話，能在一天開始前將目光由內轉向上。

2. 留意你生命中的「拉匝祿」

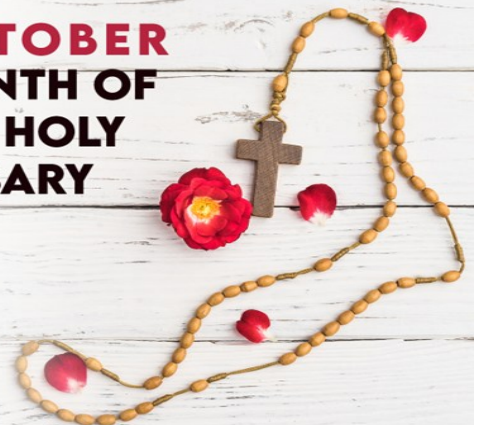
每天問自己：「誰在我門口？」

可能是一位感到被忽視的同事、一位沒人陪伴的同學、一位孤單的鄰居，或是一位默默承受重擔的家人。

這些不是英雄式的行動，而是日常的習慣。這些習慣能訓練我們的心，抗拒向內的拉力，仰望耶穌，祂會讓我們向外看見身邊的人。

Every Christian Has a Guardian Angel (Yes, Even You!) - What Scripture and the Catechism Reveal

This isn't just something fun we tell our children, it's true! Every Christian has a guardian angel.

**According to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*,
"From its beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession. 'Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life.' Already here on earth the Christian life shares by faith in the blessed company of angels and men united in God." (CCC 336)**

Where did we get the idea that every Christian has a guardian angel? Directly from Jesus himself in the Bible!

In Matthew 18.10, Jesus tells his disciples to give special attention to caring for "the little ones," because "in heaven **their angels** continually see the face of my Father in heaven." (emphasis added)

This is a reaffirmation of a teaching from the Old Testament, which repeatedly states that angels offer God's people special care and attention (cf. Ps 34:7, Ps 91:10-13, Job 33:23-24, et al.).



So, how should you interact with your guardian angel?

First, the Church says **you shouldn't name them.**

The [only angels we should name](#) are those found in Scripture (Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael).

But even if you don't know *the name* of your guardian angel, you **can** still pray to them! You can ask for their guidance, protection, and even to attend Holy Mass if you're sick or unable to attend.

There has never been a more important time than the present to truly call on your Guardian Angel for support amid the ongoing spiritual battle for human souls!

Saint Padre Pio suggests,

"Develop the beautiful habit of always thinking of him; that near us is a celestial spirit, who, from the cradle to the tomb, does not leave us for an instant, guides us, protects us as a friend, a brother; will always be a consolation to us especially in our saddest moments."

You may be familiar with this traditional prayer to one's guardian angel, below. We've also included a few more.

"Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here, ever this day, be at my side, to light and guard, rule and guide. Amen."

Novena Prayer to One's Guardian Angel

O HOLY ANGEL, whom God, by the effect of His goodness and His tender regard for my welfare, has charged with the care of my conduct, and who assists me in all my wants and comforts me in all my afflictions, who supports me when I am discouraged and continually obtains for me new favors, I return thee profound thanks, and I earnestly beseech thee, O most amiable protector, to continue thy charitable care and defense of me against the malignant attacks of all my enemies. Keep me away from all occasions of sin. Obtain for me the grace of listening attentively to thy holy inspirations and of faithfully putting them into practice. In particular, I implore thee to obtain for me the favor which I ask for by this novena. [Here mention your petition.] Protect me in all the temptations and trials of this life, but more especially at the hour of my death, and do not leave me until thou hast conducted me into the presence of my Creator in the mansions of everlasting happiness. Amen.

Guardian Angel Prayer

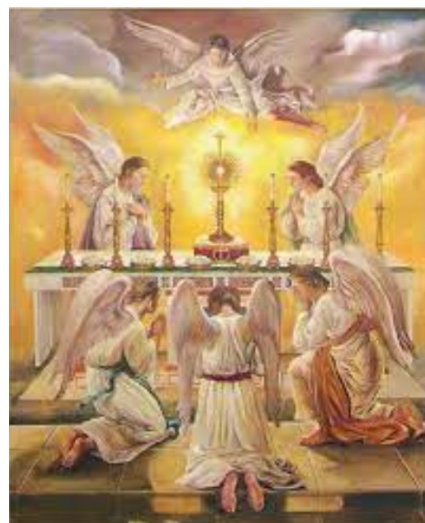
O HOLY Guardian Angel, my dear friend and solicitous guide on the dangerous way of life, to thee be heartfelt
