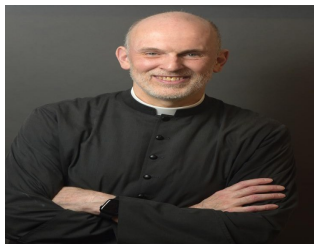

Part 11

Ordinary Time and Our Vision at Copus Christi



Ordinary Time is also a providential moment for us as a parish to **pause, reflect, and review our Vision** here at Corpus Christi.

Over the past several years, our **Ten-Year Vision** has been a true blessing, not because of any one person, but because it has served as an instrument through which God has guided and strengthened our parish. A vision, quite simply, is a *preferred picture of the future*. You need to know where you are going if you are going to get there. That is what our Vision provides.

Over the next couple of weeks, I would like to revisit this Vision with you, not for my sake, and not merely for information, but so that **you may spiritually profit** from it in your own life. What God is doing here should never be taken for granted. Vision requires work. It requires perseverance. It requires humility, because we *will* fail at times and when we do, we learn, regroup, reorganize, and keep going.

St. Paul speaks powerfully of this in **Acts 26:19–20**, when he says to King Agrippa: *"I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision."* While our parish vision is not a private revelation, it *has* been deeply prayed over, carefully discerned, and patiently developed and it continues to bear fruit.

Vision does important things in the life of a parish and in the life of every Christian. Drawing on insights highlighted in the John Maxwell Leadership Bible, we see that vision:

1. **Stops us** – Vision helps us see ourselves clearly. We begin to see not just as things are, but as we are and who God is calling us to become.
2. **Sends us** – Vision opens our eyes to others and moves us to act in service and mission.
3. **Strengthens us** – Vision sustains us through struggles, setbacks, and limited resources.
4. **Stretches us** – Vision gives us conviction to stand, confidence to speak, and compassion to share.

**Satisfies us** – Obedience to a God-given vision brings deep fulfillment and purpose.

I encourage each of you to reflect not only on our parish Vision, but also on your **personal and family vision**, especially as we look toward 2026.

As a parish, we continue to strive toward the completion of our campus master plan: the seismic upgrading of our church, the renewal of our offices and adoration spaces, and the completion of our school field. These are not merely building

projects, they serve the mission of forming disciples and building a parish rooted in faith, hope, and love.

Let us pray for one another. Let us persevere and let us never stop doing the ordinary things of life **extraordinarily well**, for the love of God.

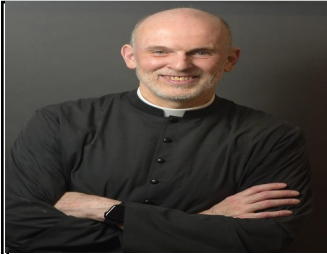

常年期第三主日  
本堂神父的話  
第二部分  
常年期與我們在基督聖體聖  
血堂的願景



常年期也是天主給我們的一個恩寵時刻，讓我們作為一個堂區能**停下來、反思，並重新檢視**我們在基督聖體聖血堂的願景。

在過去數年間，我們的**十年願景**一直是莫大的祝福，並不是因為某一個人，而是因為它成為天主帶領和鞏固我們堂區的工具。所謂願景，其實就是對未來的一幅理想圖像。如果不知道要往哪裡去，就不可能真正到達目的地，而這正是我們的願景所提供的。

在接下來的幾週，我希望能再次與大家重溫這個願景，不是為了我自己，也不只是為了提供資訊，而是希望你們能在自己的**靈修生活中從中獲益**。天主在我們當中所做的一切，絕不能視為理所當然。願景需要努力，需要毅力，也需要謙遜，因為我們有時會失敗，而當我們跌倒時，我們學習、重新整頓、再出發。

聖保祿在《宗徒大事錄》26:19 - 20 中對阿格黎帕王說了一句非常有力的話：「我對這天上的異像並沒有失信。」雖然我們堂區的願景並不是私人啟示，但它經過長時間的祈禱、辨別和耐心的制定，並且持續結出果實。

願景在堂區生活和每位基督徒的生命中，都具有重要的作用。根據《John Maxwell Leadership Bible》中的一些洞見，我們看到願景能夠：

1. **使我們停下來** — 願景幫助我們更清楚地看見自己，不只看見事物的現況，也看見我們是誰，以及天主召叫我們成為什麼樣的人。
2. **推動我們前行** — 願景讓我們看見他人的需要，並促使我們投身服務與福傳。
3. **堅強我們** — 願景在困難、挫折和資源有限時支撐著我們。
4. **擴展我們** — 願景給我們站立的信念、說話的信心，以及分享的慈悲。

**滿足我們** — 對天主所賜願景的忠信順從，帶來深層的成就感與使命感。

我鼓勵大家不僅反思我們堂區的願景，也反思你**個人和家庭的願景**，特別是在我們邁向 2026 年之際。

作為一個堂區，我們仍在努力完成整個校園的總體規劃：包括聖堂的抗震加固、辦公室與朝拜聖體小

堂的更新，以及學校操場的完工。這些不只是建築工程，而是為了成全我們的使命，培育門徒，並建立一個以信德、望德和愛德為根基的堂區。

讓我們彼此祈禱，讓我們堅持不懈，並求主讓我們永不停止把生活中平凡的事做得不平凡，為了愛天主。
