 Part IV of IV Practical Application of Immersive



The priests of the Archdiocese will be on Study Week Monday, November 17<sup>th</sup> through Friday the 21<sup>st</sup>. Father Patrick and I will be attending these days, so there will be no Mass from Tuesday through Friday. While we are away, Jerome will be conducting a Communion Service each day at the regular Mass time.

For the School, there will be a Liturgy of the Word with no Communion.

Included below is the last in the 4-part series on *Immersive*. This part gives some final take-aways/tools for all of us to implement in our personal, family, friendship, team lives.

### Shared Tools for All Three Teams

- **Start meetings in prayer, not with prayers:** Silence → Scripture → ask one question → listen.
- **Name the real enemy:** People aren't the enemy; division is. Guard unity fiercely (Eph 4:3).
- **One Priority at a Time:** Don't chase ten good things, obey One God-thing.
- **Language Upgrade:** Trade vague talk for testimony: "Here's what I think I heard from the Lord..."
- **Mercy as Lifestyle:** Forgive everyone, everything, all the time (Matt 18; CCC 2843). Transform hurt into intercession.

### A One-Week Starter Plan (pick your lane)

#### Families

- Mon: 10-min candle prayer.
- Wed: Family mercy - write a thank-you card, or drop off a meal.
- Sun: 45-min Family Council (choose one mission act).

#### Friends

- This week: One 90-min gathering with the five steps above.
- Midweek: Each texts one concrete encouragement + prayer.

### Single Persons

- Daily: 10+2 "amazement."
- Midweek: 60-min Father's Hour (journal your next right step).
- Weekend: Serve one person intentionally.

Remember to pray for the holy souls in purgatory and especially for the most forgotten souls in purgatory. They will be your great friends when they see God.

以下是沉浸式牧靈四部曲的最後一部分，提供一些可實踐於個人、家庭、友誼與團隊生活中的重點工具。

### 三大團隊共用工具

- 以祈禱開始會議，而非僅用祈禱詞：靜默 → 聖經 → 提問 → 傾聽。
- 辨明真正的敵人：人不是敵人，分裂才是。務必維護合一（參：厄弗所書 4:3）。
- 一次只專注一個優先事項：別追逐十個好事，要順服一個天父的旨意。
- 語言升級：用見證取代模糊言語：「我認為我聽見主這樣說……」
- 以慈悲為生活方式：寬恕每個人、每件事、每一次（參：瑪竇福音十八章；天主教教理 2843）。將傷痛轉化為代禱。

### 一週起步計畫（請選擇適合您的方向）

#### 家庭

- 週一：10 分鐘燭光祈禱。
- 週三：家庭慈悲行動——寫感謝卡或送餐。
- 週日：45 分鐘家庭會議（選擇一項使命行動）。

#### 朋友

- 本週：一次 90 分鐘聚會，實踐上述五步。
- 週中：每人傳送一則具體鼓勵與祈禱。

### 單身者

- 每日：10+2「驚嘆時刻」。
- 週中：60 分鐘「天父時光」（記錄下一步行動）。
- 週末：刻意服務一人。

請記得為煉獄中的靈魂祈禱，特別是那些最被遺忘的靈魂。當他們見到天主時，將成為您的摯友。
