As we enter the 25th Week of Ordinary Time, I want to share two blessings in the life of Corpus Christi.

First, **Corpus Christi has officially been recognized as an Alpha Hub Parish** - one of only a small number across Canada.

This is a wonderful recognition of the prayer, hard work, and dedication of our Alpha Core Team over many years. They have worked hard to make Alpha a place where people feel genuinely welcomed and can encounter Jesus Christ.

Please continue praying for the **supernatural fruit of Alpha**, here at Corpus Christi and throughout the Archdiocese, as a powerful means of sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.

The second blessing is the arrival of **Mara Pastrana**, who is joining our staff full-time as my **Executive Assistant**.

With my responsibilities at Corpus Christi Parish and School, the Archbishop's Rep for Notre Dame, our evangelization efforts and 10-Year Vision, as well as my responsibilities within the Archdiocese as Vicar for Priests, an Executive Assistant will be a tremendous help in keeping our mission moving forward.

There will be more about Mara in the weeks ahead, but for now, I ask you to **welcome her warmly to Corpus Christi**. Mara and her family have also registered in the parish, and we are very happy to have them with us.

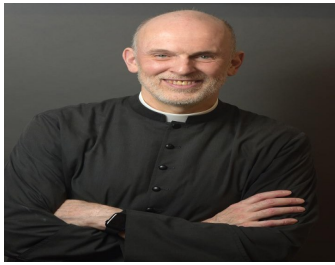
