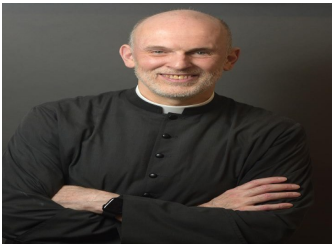

Pastor's Corner

**2nd Sunday of Easter
Divine Mercy Sunday**



This Sunday, the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday**, a feast established by Saint John Paul II in the Jubilee Year 2000. Its roots lie in the private revelations given by our Lord to Saint Faustina Kowalska.

Through Saint Faustina, Jesus revealed the depths of His merciful love, especially for sinners. He declared that humanity will not find peace until it turns with trust to His mercy. At the heart of this devotion is a simple, but profound invitation: **trust in Jesus, receive His mercy, and extend that mercy to others.**

The Divine Mercy Novena, which begins on Good Friday, prepares our hearts to receive extraordinary graces. Our Lord promised that those who approach Him with sincere trust, especially through Confession and Holy Communion, will receive an outpouring of grace comparable to a second baptism. This is not simply a devotion; it is a call to encounter the Risen Christ, whose mercy flows from His pierced Heart.

Last weekend, we also rejoice in the visible fruits of that mercy alive in our parish.

Included here is a photo of the newly baptized adults, their sponsors and the two who were received into full communion with our Discipleship Pathway team with the Church at the Easter Vigil. Their “yes” to Jesus Christ is a powerful witness and a clear sign that our Parish Vision is bearing fruit.



These moments do not happen by accident. They are the result of a parish striving to live **Evangelical Hospitality**—welcoming others, inviting them into conversation, encouraging them to take a step, perhaps to try Alpha, or even to ask about Baptism. Never underestimate how God uses a simple invitation. Often, it is the catalyst that begins a life-changing journey.

I want to express my deep gratitude to our Discipleship Pathway team and to all who serve so generously. Your faithfulness is helping to lead others to Christ. Adding to this joy, just yesterday we celebrated the Baptism of the children of those newly initiated, approximately 20-22 children! Again, we see the ripple effect of grace: entire families being drawn into the life of the Church.

As we move further into the Easter season, several important moments are before us:

- **Confirmation Retreat** – April 17 (all day for our Grade 7 students)
- **Important Mass Change:** On **Friday, April 17**, Mass will be at **7:30 AM** (*there will be no 8:00 AM Mass*) to allow students to begin their retreat
- **First Holy Communion** – April 25 at 9:00 AM
- **Confirmation** – April 30, celebrated by Archbishop Smith

I ask all parishioners to keep our students and their families in your prayers during this important time of preparation.

Finally, I invite each of you to reflect on a simple, but important question:

What is the Lord calling you to do?

Each of us has been given time and talents. The question is not whether we have something to offer, (all of you do!), but whether we are willing to offer it. The Lord does not ask for something extraordinary, but for our willingness. How is He inviting you to build up His Kingdom here at Corpus Christi? Let us continue to walk together as a parish on a mission, rooted in Christ, alive in His mercy, and committed to reaching others.

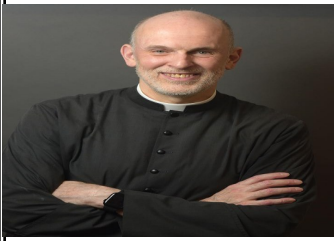

Pastor's Corner

復活期第二主日
本堂神父的話
天主慈悲主日



本主日，教會慶祝**天主慈悲主日**，這個慶日由聖若望保祿二世在二千禧年正式設立。它的根源來自我們的主耶穌向聖傅天娜所啟示的私人默示。

透過聖傅天娜，耶穌向我們揭示祂深不可測的慈悲之愛，特別是對罪人。祂宣告，人類若不以信賴歸向祂的慈悲，將找不到真正的平安。這敬禮的核心是一個簡單卻深刻的邀請：**信賴耶穌、領受祂的慈悲，並把這份慈悲延伸給他人。**

從耶穌受難日開始的**慈悲九日敬禮**，幫助我們的心預備好領受特別的恩寵。主耶穌曾許諾，那些以真誠信賴親近祂的人，特別是透過告解和領聖體，將會領受如同「第二次洗禮」般的恩寵傾注。這不僅是一項敬禮，更是一個邀請：去邂逅復活的基督，祂的慈悲從祂被刺透的聖心湧流出來。

上個週末，我們也在本堂親眼看見這份慈悲在我們團體中結出的可見果實。

在此刊登的是剛領洗的成人、他們的代父母，以及兩位加入全共融的教友，與我們的門徒培育團隊在復活前夕守夜禮中的合照。他們對耶穌基督的「是」是一個強而有力的見證，也是我們堂區願景正在結果的明顯標記。

這些時刻並非偶然發生，而是因為整個堂區努力活出**福傳式的款待**——歡迎他人、與他們交談、鼓勵他們邁進一步，也許是參加 Alpha，或甚至詢問關於領洗。千萬不要低估天主如何使



用一個簡單的邀請。往往，它就是改變生命旅程的起點。我在此向我們的門徒培育團隊，以及所有慷慨服務的人，表達深深的感謝。你們的忠信正幫助更多人走向基督。

更添喜樂的是，就在昨天，我們為那些新入教者的孩子們舉行了洗禮，約有二十至二十二位孩子！我們再次看見恩寵的漣漪

效應：整個家庭被吸引進入教會的生活。

隨著我們進入復活期的後段，前面有幾個重要時刻：

- **堅振避靜**：4月17日（七年級學生全天）
- **重要彌撒時間更改**：4月17日（星期五）彌撒將於早上7:30舉行（當天沒有8:00彌撒），以便學生開始避靜
- **初領聖體**：4月25日上午9:00
- **堅振聖事**：4月30日，由 Smith 總主教主持我請大家在這段重要的準備時期，為我們的學生及其家庭祈禱。

最後，我邀請每一位思考一個簡單卻重要的問題：

主正在召叫你做什麼？

我們每個人都領受了時間和才華。問題不是我們是否有東西可以奉獻（你們每一位都有！），而是我們是否願意奉獻。主並不要求我們做非凡的事，而是要求我們的願意。祂如何邀請你在基督聖體堂內建設祂的天國？

讓我們繼續作為一個使命中的堂區同行，紮根於基督，活在祂的慈悲中，並致力於接觸更多的人。

願天主降福你們。
