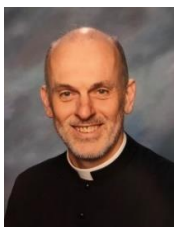

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last Saturday evening the parish celebrated my 35th Anniversary to the Priesthood and Induction in the BC Hall of Fame. The event was a wonderful gathering of parishioners and friends beyond the parish. We were honored that His Grace was present for this occasion.

The evening was also a fundraiser of our new School, Parish Centre and Child Care Centre. As everyone knows, but perhaps would like to not really remember, we now have a \$7 million debt to pay off.

In our 10 Year Vision we see this debt which has an amortization of 14 years being paid down in 10 years. As your pastor – and I would go to the wall believing that everyone would agree with me on this point – it would be so good to “kick this debt to the curb” (an expression meaning to get rid of it as soon as we can!!!), so that we can focus on building up people, youth ministry, young families, senior ministry, ALPHA, which is such a huge blessing in this parish right now, and so many other things.

We raised \$115,000 on Saturday evening and monies are still coming in. I am so grateful for everyone's generosity. Every donation and pledge is so important, as it represents your commitment to further the Vision of Corpus Christi.

We give with different amounts, but we can all give with the same intensity of love of God and each other.

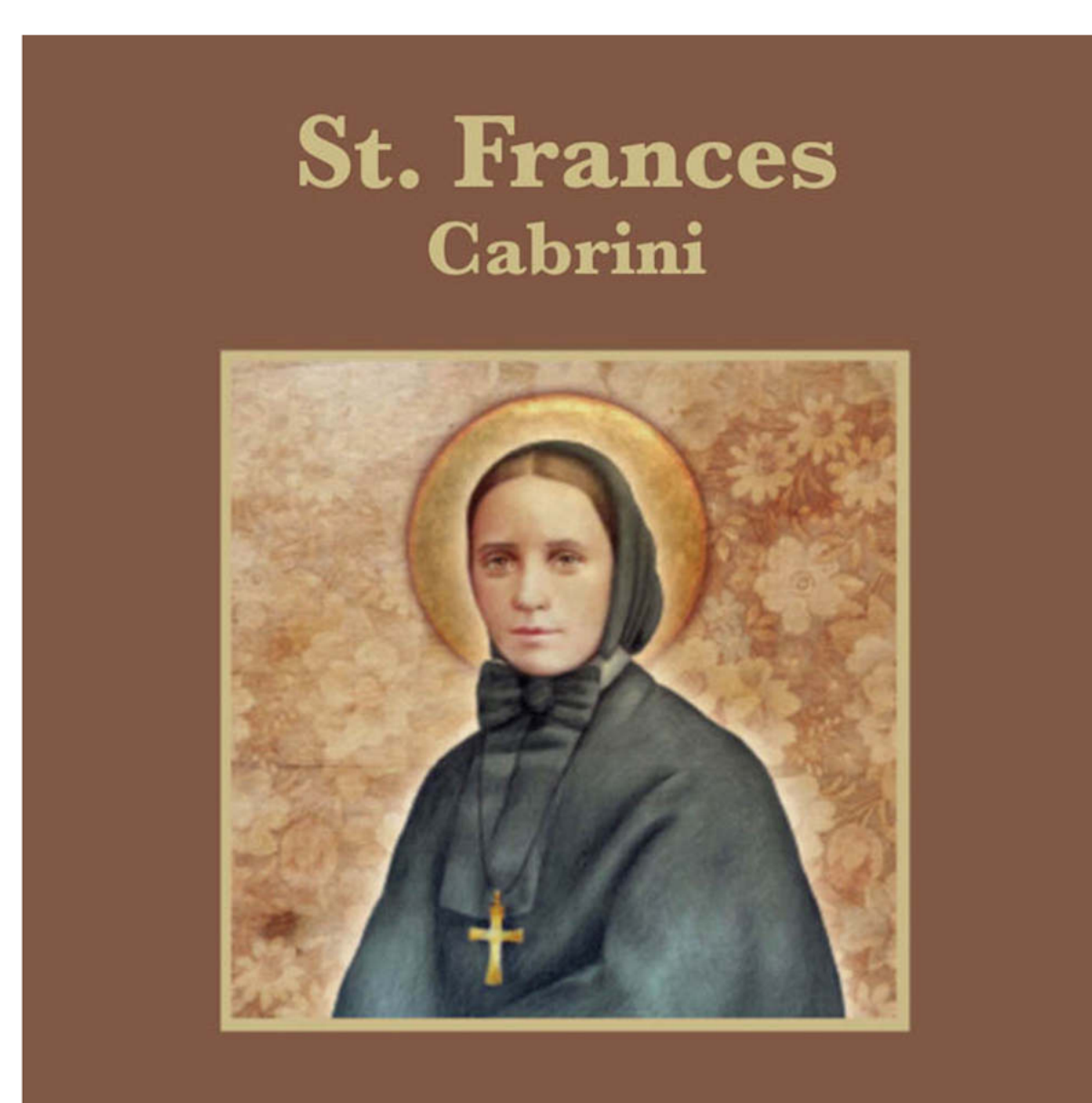
Saints Peter and Paul
