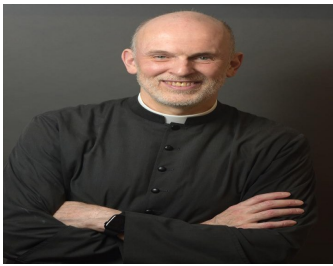
Stewardship Reflection

"What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" - Matthew 16:26

St. Francis of Assisi said, "Remember, you are what you are in the eyes of God, and nothing else." We often forget this stewardship wisdom when we spend all of our time, talent and treasure to gain more of the world's riches. We need to set our priorities based on God's values and not the values of the material world.

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pastor's Corner

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Many parishes naturally slow down during the summer months. **That has certainly not been the case at Corpus Christi.** In fact, this summer has given us some very visible signs of the Holy Spirit at work, especially in the lives of our young people.

I think it is important that we recognize these blessings — **not so that we can boast about what is happening at Corpus Christi, but so that we can be grateful for what God is doing among us.** And we should never take these things for granted.

Over the past several weeks, we have seen three particularly beautiful examples.

At the end of July, **70–80 young people from three parishes gathered for our Youth Retreat**, together with their leaders and volunteers — well over 100 people altogether. It was a profound opportunity for our young people to pray, encounter Christ, experience friendship, and become more open to the work of the Holy Spirit in their lives.

Then, from **August 10–14, we held our Altar Server Camp**, with approximately 40 altar servers of various ages. This was much more than simply an opportunity to gather and have fun. They learned more about their Catholic faith, deepened friendships with one another, and grew in their understanding of what it means to serve the Lord at the altar.

Finally, from **August 17–21, we welcomed 78 children for Vacation Bible School**, supported by another 30–40 youth and adult leaders and volunteers. Once again, more than 100 people filled our parish with prayer, faith, energy, friendship and joy.

These things do not simply happen.

They are the fruit of **prayer, vision, generosity and a tremendous amount of work behind the scenes.** They are also visible fruits of our **10-Year Vision** and of our willingness as a parish to ask what God wants Corpus Christi to become — and then to pray and work toward it.

I especially want to thank the many youth and adults who organized and served at these events. You have given our children and young people opportunities to come together, to pray, to build genuine Christian friendships and, most

importantly, **to encounter Jesus Christ and come to know Him more deeply.** Thank you!

We sometimes hear that young people are abandoning Christianity or are no longer interested in the Church. There are certainly challenges, but that is not the whole story. **Many young people today are searching — searching for truth, beauty, goodness, meaning and ultimately for God.** We are seeing evidence of that right here at Corpus Christi.

So what should our response be?

First, **give thanks.** These are gifts from God.

Second, **do not become complacent.** What is happening today is not guaranteed tomorrow. God's grace invites a response from us.

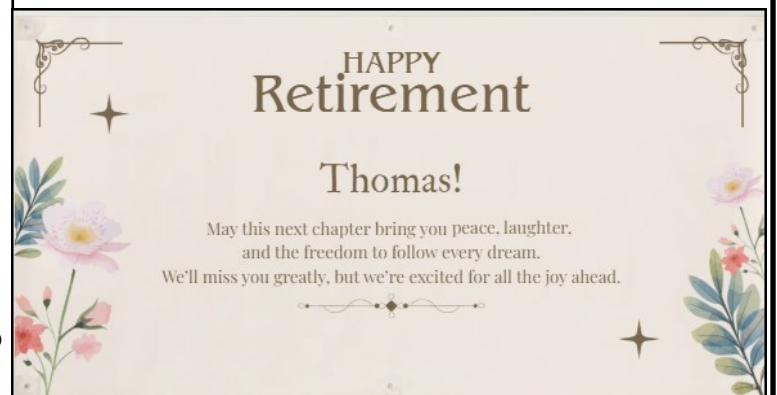
And third, **ask where God is calling you to participate.** These blessings are not simply for the people who organize programs or attend them. They belong to our whole parish, and every one of us has some part to play in the mission Christ has entrusted to Corpus Christi.

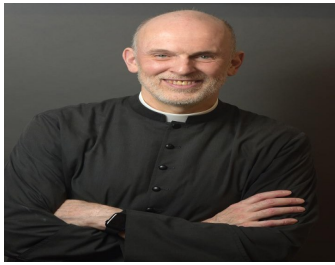
There is much more to come this fall. **Alpha begins again in September**, and I encourage you to consider Alpha yourself if you have never attended — or perhaps invite someone you know who is searching and would benefit from it.

For everything the Lord has done among us this summer, **let us truly give Him thanks. And for everything He still desires to do among us, let us remain open, generous and ready to respond.**

常年期第二十二主日 本堂神父的話



許多堂區在夏季時自然會放慢步伐，**基督聖體堂卻完全不是如此**。事實上，這個夏天讓我們看見了許多非常明顯的聖神工作，尤其是在我們的青少年身上。

我認為，我們必須認出這些恩典——**不是為了誇耀基督聖體堂正在發生什麼，而是為了感謝天主在我們當中所成就的一切**。我們也絕不能把這些事情視為理所當然。

在過去的幾週裡，我們看見了三個特別美好的例子。

七月底時，來自三個堂區的七、八十位青少年聚集在一起，**連同他們的領袖和義工，總共超過一百人，參加了我們的青年退省**。這次退省為青少年提供了一個深刻的機會去祈禱、與基督相遇、體驗友誼，並更敞開心接受聖神在他們生命中的工作。

接著，在八月十日至十四日，我們舉行了**輔祭營**，約有四十位不同年齡的輔祭參加。這遠遠不只是一次聚會和娛樂的機會，他們更深入學習了天主教信仰、加深彼此的友誼，也更明白在祭台前服務主的真正意義。

最後，在八月十七日至二十一日，我們迎來了七十八位參加**聖經夏令營**的兒童，並由另外三、四十位青年及成人領袖和義工協助。再一次，超過一百人以祈禱、信仰、活力、友誼和喜樂充滿了整個堂區。

這些事情並不是自然而然發生的。

它們是祈禱、願景、慷慨，以及大量幕後工作的成果。它們也是我們**十年願景**的可見果實，更是我們整個堂區願意問天主：祂希望基督聖體堂成為什麼——並願意為此祈禱和努力的結果。

我特別要感謝所有在這些活動中籌劃和服務的青年及成人。你們讓我們的兒童和青少年有機會聚在一起、祈禱、建立真正的基督徒友誼，**更重要的是，讓他們遇見耶穌基督，並更深地認識祂**。謝謝你們！

我們有時會聽到年輕人正在離開基督信仰或對教會不再感興趣。確實有挑戰，但這並不是全部的故事。今天許多年輕人正在尋找——尋找真理、美善、意義，最終尋找天主。我們就在基督聖體堂親眼看見了這些跡象。

那麼，我們應該如何回應呢？

首先，**感謝天主**。這些都是祂的恩賜。

第二，**不要自滿**。今天發生的事並不保證明天也會發生。天主的恩寵需要我們的回應。

第三，**問問自己：天主正在召叫你參與哪一部分？**這些恩典不只是給那些籌劃或參加活動的人，而是屬於整個堂區，我們每一個人都在基督託付給基督聖體堂的使命中有自己的角色。

這個秋季還有更多事情即將展開。**Alpha 將在九月再次開始**，如果你從未參加過，我鼓勵你考慮參加；或者邀請你身邊正在尋找、並可能從中受益的人一起來。

對於天主在這個夏天在我們當中所成就的一切，**讓我們真心向祂獻上感謝；也讓我們對祂仍渴望在我們當中成就的一切，保持開放、慷慨並準備好回應**。
