**Pastor's Corner**

**5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter**  
**Pastor's Corner**



Sunday's readings invite us into three clear and practical reflections for our Christian life: **leadership in the Church, our identity as a priestly people, and our communion with God through Jesus Christ.**

**1. A Lesson in Leadership: Staying Faithful to the Mission**

In the **Acts of the Apostles**, we see the institution of the **diaconate**. The Apostles recognize that the needs of the growing community are real and pressing, but so is their primary calling: to preach the Gospel.

Rather than trying to do everything themselves, they **delegate and empower** others. The deacons are entrusted not only with practical service ("waiting at table"), but also with proclaiming the Word, seen clearly in the lives of **Ss. Stephen and Philip**.

This reveals a timeless leadership principle:  
**Know your mission. Stay in your lane. Empower others.**

The Church flourishes when each person embraces their God-given role.

**2. A Royal Priesthood: Who You Are in Christ**

In the Second Reading, St. Peter reminds us of a profound truth: through Jesus Christ, we have become a **"royal priesthood."**

This is not the same as the ministerial priesthood, but it is real and powerful. Through Baptism, every Christian is called to:

- Offer their life to God
- Live in holiness
- Be a bridge between the world and the Lord

In the Old Testament, this priestly calling was lost through sin.

In Christ, it has been **restored**.

This means your daily life, your work, your family life, your sacrifices, can become a true offering to God.

**3. Jesus: The Way to the Father**

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks with clarity and authority:

**He is the way to the Father.**

To know Jesus is to know the Father.  
To love Jesus is to love the Father.

We are not called into a vague spirituality, but into a **deep, personal communion with the Holy Trinity** - Father, Son, and

Holy Spirit.

**4. The Month of May: Turning to Our Blessed Mother**

As we begin the month of May, the Church invites us to renew our devotion to **Our Blessed Mother**.

This month is an opportunity to deepen that relationship in simple, concrete ways:

- **Pray the Rosary**  
Start with just one decade if needed (1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's).  
Pray slowly. Reflect on the mysteries.
- **Pause and Ask**  
Between decades, bring a specific intention, for example:
  - ◇ The Nativity → ask for simplicity
  - ◇ The Visitation → ask for charity toward others
- **Daily Marian Prayers**
  - ◇ *Regina Caeli* (during Easter)
  - ◇ *Angelus* (after Easter)
  - ◇ *Memorare*
  - ◇ Three Hail Mary's before bed (for purity)

These are not just devotions, they are **pathways into deeper prayer**: vocal prayer, meditation, and even contemplation.

This week, take one concrete step:

- ☑ Begin, or renew, your Marian devotion - start small, but be faithful.
- ☑ Offer one part of your daily life consciously to God as a priestly offering.
- ☑ Spend a moment each day turning your heart to Jesus, the way to the Father.

Let us continue to walk together in this Easter season, as a people called, chosen, and sent.

復活期第五主日

本堂神父的話

主日的讀經邀請我們進入三個清晰而實際的反省：教會中的領導、我們作為司祭子民的身分，以及我們藉著耶穌基督與天主的共融。

一、領導的榜樣：忠於使命

在《宗徒大事錄》中，我們看到**執事職**的設立。宗徒們意識到日益成長的團體有真實而迫切的需要，但他們的首要召叫仍然是宣講福音。

他們沒有試圖事事親力親為，而是**委派並賦權**他人。執事們不僅負責實際的服務（「供應飲食」），也肩負宣講聖道的使命，這在**聖斯德望**和**聖斐理伯**的事蹟中清楚可見。

這揭示了一個歷久常新的領導原則：

**認清你的使命，專注於你的本分，並成全他人。**

當每個人都擁抱天主所賜的角色時，教會便得以興盛。

二、皇家的司祭：你在基督內的身分

在第二篇讀經中，聖伯多祿提醒我們一個深刻的真理：藉著耶穌基督，我們已成為「**皇家的司祭**」。

這與聖秩司祭職不同，但同樣真實而有力。藉著聖洗聖事，每位基督徒都蒙召去：

- 將自己的生命奉獻給天主
- 生活於聖德之中
- 成為世界與上主之間的橋樑

在舊約中，這司祭性的召叫因罪而失落；

在基督內，它已被**恢復**。

這意味著你的日常生活、你的工作、你的家庭生活，以及你的犧牲，都可以成為獻給天主的真正祭獻。

三、耶穌：通往天父的道路

在福音中，耶穌以清晰而權威的語氣宣告：

**祂就是通往天父的道路。**

認識耶穌，就是認識天父；

愛耶穌，就是愛天父。

我們不是被召進入一種模糊的靈修，而是進入**與至聖聖三一**

——**聖父、聖子、聖神**——之間深刻而個人的共融。

四、聖母月：轉向我們的榮福童貞聖母

當我們開始五月，教會邀請我們更新對榮福童貞聖母的敬禮。

這個月是一個機會，讓我們以簡單而具體的方式，加深這份關係：

• **誦念玫瑰經**

如有需要，可先從一端開始（1遍天主經，10遍聖母經）。

慢慢祈禱，默想奧蹟。

• **停下來祈求**

在每端之間，提出一個具體意向，例如：

- 耶穌誕生 → 祈求純樸
- 聖母訪親 → 祈求愛德

• **每日聖母經文祈禱**

- 《天皇后喜樂經》（復活期）
- 《三鐘經》（復活期後）
- 《求爾垂憐經》
- 睡前誦念三遍聖母經（為求潔德）

這些不僅是敬禮，更是引領我們**進入更深祈禱的途徑**：□ 禱、默想，甚至觀想。

本週，請踏出一個具體的步伐：

□ 開始或更新你對聖母的敬禮——從小處著手，但要持之以恆。

□ 有意識地將你日常生活的一部分奉獻給天主，作為司祭性的祭獻。

□ 每天花一點時間，把你的心轉向耶穌——祂是通往天父的道路。

讓我們在這復活期中繼續一同前行，作為一群蒙召、被揀選、並被派遣的子民。
