Next weekend, we are excited to launch this year's Project Advance at Corpus Christi Parish. Volunteers will be in the vestibule after each Mass for three weekends to answer questions and receive pledges.

Project Advance is an important opportunity for us to come together as a parish community and make a meaningful difference. Each year, the appeal provides critical funding for ministries and initiatives throughout our Archdiocese, while also directly supporting the needs and priorities of our own parish.

Together, through our generosity and shared commitment, we can reach our goal and continue building a strong and welcoming parish community for all.



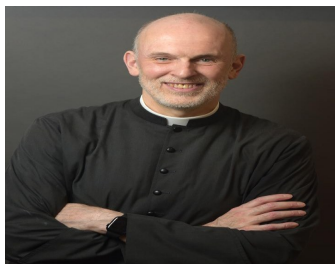
Corpus Christi Parish is seeking a highly capable **Executive Assistant (EA)** to serve as a key partner to the Pastor.

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time



As I go through the 4 Core Values of our 10 Year Vision, I want to summarize my last homily below. I pray this helps people know it, interiorize it and live it out.

Two weeks ago, on the **21st Sunday in Ordinary Time**, the readings gave us a powerful lesson about leadership.

In the first reading, Eliakim was entrusted with “the key of the House of David.” In the Gospel, Jesus used that same powerful image when He entrusted Peter with “the keys of the kingdom of heaven.” Peter was given real authority, but he was not the King. He was the Steward. **Leadership in the Church is never ownership; it is stewardship.**

Jesus also showed us how His mission would continue. He did not simply gather followers. **He formed apostles.** He prepared Peter to lead. Peter and the apostles formed others, who in turn formed others. Nearly two thousand years later, the Church continues because one generation of disciples has handed the faith and the mission on to the next.

This is at the heart of one of our four Core Values at Corpus Christi: **Multiplying Leaders.**

St. Paul gives us an extraordinary picture of this when he tells Timothy: **“What you have heard from me... entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also”** (2 Timothy 2:2).

Paul is thinking **four generations ahead**:

- **Paul forms Timothy.**
- **Timothy forms faithful leaders.**
- Those leaders form **others.**

That is multiplication.

Christian leadership is not about making ourselves indispensable. It is about preparing others to carry the mission forward.

So, what might **Multiplying Leaders** look like for us at Corpus Christi?

- **Look around:** Who has gifts, or the potential that perhaps they do not yet see in themselves?
- **Invite someone:** Bring another person alongside you rather than always doing the work yourself.
- **Invest in someone:** Teach them what you know. Encourage them. Give them opportunities to grow.
- **Give responsibility away:** Good leaders do not hold onto everything; they entrust meaningful responsibility to others.
- **Think beyond yourself:** Ask, “If I were no longer doing this

tomorrow, who could carry it forward?”

- **Pray for leaders:** Ask the Lord to raise up new leaders in our families, school, ministries and parish.

This applies to all of us. Parents are forming the next generation of Catholics. Teachers are forming young people who will influence others. Ministry leaders should always be looking for someone to bring alongside them and prepare.

Every leader is a steward for a time.

Our responsibility is to be faithful with what Christ has entrusted to us and to make sure that, when our time is finished, **someone else is ready to carry the mission forward.**

This weekend I will be speaking about Engaged Disciples.

ALPHA at Corpus Christi

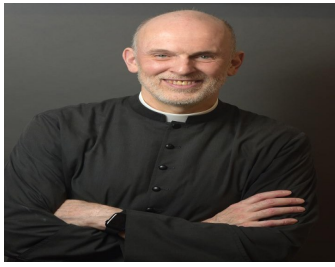

常年期第二十三主日 本堂神父的話



在我逐一講解我們堂區十年願景的四項核心價值時，我想在此總結我上一次的講道內容。願這能幫助大家認識、內化並活出這些核心價值。

兩週前，在**常年期第二十一主日的讀經中**，我們看到了關於領導的一個深刻教導。

在第一篇讀經中，以里亞金被託付了「達味家之鑰」。在福音中，耶穌也用了同樣有力的形象，把「天國的鑰匙」交給伯多祿。伯多祿被賦予真正的權柄，但他不是君王，而是管家。**教會中的領導從來不是擁有，而是託付。**

耶穌也向我們展示了祂的使命將如何延續。祂不只是召集跟隨者，**而是培育宗徒**。祂準備伯多祿去領導。伯多祿和宗徒們培育了其他人，而那些人又再培育更多的人。近兩千年後，教會仍然延續，因為一代又一代的門徒把信仰和使命傳遞下去。

這正是我們聖堂四項核心價值之一的重心：**培育領袖**（**Multiplying Leaders**）。

聖保祿在寫給弟茂德時給了我們一個非常清晰的圖像：「你由我所聽到的……要託付給那些忠信的人，使他們也能教導別人。」（弟後 2:2）保祿心中想的是四代的傳承：

保祿培育弟茂德。

弟茂德培育忠信的領袖。

這些領袖再培育其他人。

這就是倍增。

基督徒的領導不是讓自己變得不可或缺，而是培育他人，使使命能繼續向前。

那麼，在我們聖堂內，「**培育領袖**」可以如何實踐呢？
環顧四周：誰擁有恩賜，或是誰有潛能但自己尚未察覺？
邀請他人：不要總是自己做所有事，而是帶另一個人一起同行。

投資於他人：把你所知道的教給他們，鼓勵他們，給他們成長的機會。

放手責任：好的領袖不會把所有事情抓在手裡，而是把有意義的責任託付給他人。

超越自己：問問自己：「如果明天我不能再做這件事，誰可以接手？」

為領袖祈禱：求主在我們的家庭、學校、各項善會和堂區中興起新的領袖。

這適用於我們每一個人。父母正在培育下一代的天主教徒；老師正在培育將來會影響他人的青年；善會領袖應該常常尋找可以帶在身邊並培育的人。

每一位領袖都是在某段時間內被託付的管家。

我們的責任，是忠信地善用基督交託給我們的一切，並確保當我們的時間結束時，有人已準備好承接使命。

本週末我將會講解「投入的門徒」。
